

Sunday Feb 23-1874

Lat 31.51 First part of this day strong breeze from
Long 118.48 the ESE. Weather squally. Middle and
Latter parts the same. About 2 P. M spoke
the Bark Rainbow at sun down shortened
sail and wore ship heading NE by E and
so ends this day.

Monday Feb 24

Lat 31.21 First part of this day strong breeze from
Long 119.46 the ESE ship on the Starboard tack heading
in NE middle and latter parts the same
started water. Saw one sail at sun down
took in sail and so ends this day.

Tuesday Feb 25

Lat 31.20 First part of this day good breeze from
Long 119.51 the NW. Middle and latter parts the same
Saw five sails The Niger. Coral. Osmanli
Cutting whales. Spoke the Osmanli. Rainbow
and Niger at sun down took in sail on the
Eastward tack and so ends this day.

Wednesday Feb 26

Lat 31.34 First part of this day light breeze from
Long 119.25 the NW at day light made sail and wore ship.
Saw five sails and a school of Blackfish
lowered the starboard boat and got one
Middle and latter parts the same at sun
down took in sail and so ends this day.

Thursday Feb 27

Lat 31.22 First part good breeze from the NW at noon
Long 119.20 saw the ship Niger to the wind ward whaling
beat to the windward just before dark lowered
three boats with out success. Saw five ships
all whaling supposed they all got whales.
because saw several chud down so ends.

Friday Feb 28-1874

Lat 31.25 First part of this day strong breeze from the
Long 119.43 SSE. Middle and latter parts the same. Saw
five sails cutting. Boiled the Blackfish and
repaired the lower main top sail. at sun down
took in sail to lower main top sail so ends.

Saturday Feb 29

Lat 30.58 First part of this day strong breeze from the
ESE. Middle and latter parts the same. Saw
two sails. Started water and wet hold so ends.

Sunday March 1

Lat 31.55 First part of this day blowing gale from the
Long 119.59 ESE Middle and latter parts the same at sun
down took in sail to lower main top sail
Saw one sail and so ends this day.

Monday March 3

First part of this day strong breeze from
the ENE and thick weather. Middle and latter
parts the same. at sun down took in sail
and so ends this day.

Tuesday March 4

First part of this day moderate breeze from
the ENE and thick fog ship running NE by E
on one tack and S by W on the other. Middle
latter parts the same and so ends this day.

Wednesday March 5

Lat 31.10 First part of this day fine weather and light
Long 119.04 breeze. Middle and latter parts the same
Saw three sails about 10 A.M. gambled the
Abram Barker and the Bark Madlyn Capt
Soule at sun down took in sail and so ends.
