

Thursday March 6-1874

Lat 30.52 First part of this day light breeze from the
Long 178.08 E by S ship beating to the E Middle and
Latter parts the same Started water. Saw
two sails at sun down took all but the
storm-sails and so ends this day.

Friday March 7

Lat 31.06 First part of this day good breeze from the
Long 176.52 E by S ~~at~~ at day light made sail steer-
ing S W Middle part steering S S W Latter
part the same. Saw nothing. so ends

Saturday Mar. 8

Lat 31.05 First part of this day light breeze from
Long 174.46 the E by S at day light made sail and
kept off steering W Middle and Latter
parts the same Saw one fin back so ends

Sunday Mar 9

First part of this day light breeze from
the N W ship heading W by S Middle and
Latter parts the same. Saw nothing at sun
down took in sail and so end this day.

Monday Mar 10

First part of this day light breeze and calms
Middle and Latter parts the same. Saw several
grampus. Repaired the mizen top sail at
sun down took in sail and so ends this day.

Tuesday Mar 11

Lat 32.40 First part of this day strong breeze from the
Long 176.04 N. Ship heading E S E Middle and Latter parts
the same. Saw one sail. Started water and
repaired the fore gallant sail at sun down
took in sail and so ends this day.

Wednesday Mar 12 1874

First part of this day strong breeze from NNE
Ship on the port tack heading E by S. Weather
thick Middle and Latter parts the same.
Repaired the jib. Saw nothing and so ends.

Thursday Mar 13

Lat 34.07 First part of this day strong breeze from
the NNE. Weather thick at 10 AM. wore ship
heading NW by N. Middle and Latter parts
the same. Saw nothing and so end this day.

Friday Mar 14

First part of this day good breeze from the
NNE with rain and fog ship beating to the
N Middle and Latter parts the same Saw
nothing. Rove new jib and fly jib down hauls
and fore bunt-line and so ends this day.

Saturday Mar 15

First part of this day good breeze from
the N and thick fog. Ship working to the N
Saw nothing. Started flour and butter
Middle and Latter parts the same and
so ends this day.

Sunday Mar 16

Lat 32.40 First part of this day good breeze from
the W ship heading N W W Middle and
Latter parts wind from the S. Steering N W
Saw nothing. Ship under whole top sails
and courses. and so end this day.

Monday Mar 17

Lat 31.45 First part good breeze from the W ship steering
ENE Middle and Latter parts the same at sun
down saw French Rock bearing ESE distance 10
miles. Started water and Pork and so ends.
