

Saturday March 29

First part of this day strong breeze from the NE thick and squally took up starboard anchor and cleared up and so ends.

Sunday March 30

First part of this day good weather and light breeze. Sent Larboard watch ashore on liberty all returned at sun down and so ends.

Monday March 31

These 24 hours good weather and light breeze Employed in painting ship. dyed the sails and so ends this day.

Tuesday April 1

These 24 hours fine weather and light breeze at day light took the anchor and stood in to the landing and anchored in 10 fathoms with 40 fathoms of chain out. Still painting.

Wednesday April 2

These 24 hours good weather finished painting and sent a raft of cask ashore for water so ends.

Thursday April 3

These 24 hours good weather Employed in taking up the ground tier forward and cooping it and stowing it back. Sent a raft ashore so ends.

Friday Apr. 4

These 24 hours good weather. Still cooping the ground. Sent another raft ashore and so ends.

Saturday Apr 5

These 24 hours good weather finished the ground tier. and washed the ship and so ends this day.

Sunday April 6 1874

These 24 hours fine weather and strong breeze Held service aboard the ship by a missionary from Auckland and it was well attended.

Monday April 7

These 24 hours fine weather and light breeze sent the watch ashore on liberty and all returned. sent a crew in filling water and so ends.

Tuesday April 8

These 24 hours fine weather and good breeze from the NE. Starboard watch ashore on liberty. Employed in filling water so ends.

Wednesday April 9

These 24 hours fine weather larboard watch ashore on liberty. Employed in filling water and so ends this day.

Thursday April 10

These 24 hours fine breeze from the W with rain got off a raft of water and stowed it in the middle tier forward. got a tank from ship Niger and set it up between decks. Carpenter varnishing the cabin and so ends this day.

Friday April 11

These 24 hours fine weather and light breeze from the NE. Employed in filling water. got off a raft and stowed it and so ends.

Saturday April 12

Received These 24 hours fine weather and good breeze from the W. Employed in filling water. Capt. Chase went to Auckland. Sent a cask of sperm oil containing 121 gals per steamer to Auckland and so ends this day.
