

Sunday April 27-1874

These 24 hours fine weather and light breeze part of the crew ashore and so ends this day.

Monday April 28

These 24 hours fine weather and light breeze. Employed in braking out and cooping oil. And so ends this day.

Tuesday April 29

Edward Weeks deserted. These 24 hours fine weather and strong breeze. Employed in cooping and filling the oil. got off a raft from shore and stowed it. and so ends this day.

Wednesday April 30

These 24 hours light breeze and a heavy rain storm. At noon took the anchor and hauled along side the English Bark Chaudiere to discharge oil. Caught the steward and put him in jail so ends.

Thursday May 1

These 24 hours fine weather with rain part of the time. unable to ship oil on account of the merchant ship not being ready.

Friday May 2

These 24 hours fine weather about noon commenced to stow finished at dark put aboard 207 barrels of sperm oil and and 5 barrels of slush. Charles Simone and Walter Phillips deserted. and so ends.

Saturday May 3-1874

These 24 hours strong breeze from the E with rain. Employed in getting off water and looking for runaways and so ends.

Sunday May 4

These 24 hours fine weather and moderate breeze. part of the crew ashore and so ends.

Monday May 5

These 24 hours fine weather and light breeze Employed in stowing water and so ends.

Tuesday May 6

These 24 hours fine weather and light breeze Employed in getting off ~~stow~~ stores and the Capt. things. took the anchor and stood out about half a mile received aboard two new men named Charles Brown and so ends.

Wednesday May 7

Lat 34.47 Long 174.04 First part of this day strong breeze from the E at day light took the Capt and family aboard also Edmund Weeks and David Mason about 7 A.M. took the anchor and stood out Middle and Latter parts strong breeze and so ends.

Thursday May 8

Lat 32.30 Long 175.06 First part of this day strong breeze from the E & ship heading N & under short sail Middle and Latter parts the same. At sun down spoke the Bark John Howland Capt Cole nothing since leaving port.
