

Wednesday May 28-1874

Lat 25.10 First part strong breeze from the W ship
Long 175.45 steering NNE. Middle and Latter parts
on the Wind heading NNW. Saw nothing
put up new minnen Royal rigging. at sun
down shortened sail and so ends this day.

Thursday May 29

Lat 25.12 First part of this day good breeze from
Long 176.44 the SE ship heading to the SW Middle
and Latter parts the same. Booped the
Bread and Flour and put it between
decks. Saw nothing. Repaired the spanker
and so ends this day.

Friday May 30

Lat 26.01 First part of this day good breeze from
the SE by E ship heading to the SW. Middle
and Latter parts the same. Saw one fin
back. Employed in setting up shooks and
trimming ship at sun down shortened
sail. and so ends this day.

Saturday May 31

First of this day strong breeze from the
E. ship steering S by E Middle and Latter parts
steering WSW. Saw one fin back. started water
Repaired the minnen top sail. at sun down
took in sail and so ends this day.

Sunday June 1

Lat 28.17 First part of this day strong breeze from
the N ship steering WSW. Weather thick and
hazy. Middle and Latter parts the same
Saw nothing. at sun down took in sail
and luffed to heading S. and so ends.

Monday June 2-1874

First part of this day light breeze from the
WNW ship heading SSW. Middle and Latter
