

Sunday June 8-1874

Lat 25.00 First part of this day light breeze E & S. Ship
Long 173.08 steering W by S Middle and Latter parts
wind from the SE Saw nothing. So ends.

Monday June 9

First part of this day light air and calms
Middle and Latter parts light breeze from
the S. Ship heading W by S. Saw nothing. Re-
paired the fore gallant sail. Wet hold and
so ends this day.

Tuesday June 10

Lat 24.57 First part of this day Calm. Middle
and Latter parts light breeze from the W & W
Saw nothing. Repaired the fore top sail
made a new mast-coat to the minnen
and so ends this day.

Wednesday June 11

Lat 25.20 First part of this day strong breeze from
Long 171.02 S W by W. at 7 A.M. tacked ship heading W & W
Middle and Latter parts the same. Saw one
fin back. and so ends this day.

Thursday June 12

First part of this day strong breeze from the
Lat 24.29 S W. Ship beating to the S and W. Middle and
Long 171.07 Latter parts the same. Saw nothing. Employed
in working up the old junk and so ends.

Friday June 13

Lat 24.58 First part of this day good breeze from the
Long 170.28 S W. Ship beating to windward. Middle part
the same. Latter part strong breeze. Saw one
fin back. Employed in making rattling
stuff. And so ends this day.

Saturday June 14-1874

Lat 24.57 First part of this day light breeze from the
Long 169.50 S W by S. Ship on the port tack heading W by S
Middle and Latter parts light air and
calms. Saw one fin back. Employed in mak-
ing rattling stuff. Started water and 8 gallons
of oil to burn and so ends this day.

Sunday June 15

Lat 24.59 First part of this day light breeze from
Long 168.42 the N Ship steering W & W. Middle and Latter
parts strong breeze. steering S W by W. Saw
several fin backs and so ends this day.

Monday June 16

First part of this day Calm with rain and
fog. Middle and Latter parts good breeze
from the W. Ship on the starboard tack
heading S by W with rain. Saw nothing so ends.

Tuesday June 17

Lat 26.23 First part of this day strong breeze from
Long 168.17 the W Middle and Latter parts the same
Ship heading S by W. Saw nothing. Rove new
fore stay sail halyards and new fore top mast
stay sail down haul and so ends this day.

Wednesday June 18

Lat 26.08 First part of this day fine weather and
Long 167.45 good breeze from the S W. Ship beating to
the W. Middle and Latter parts the same
Saw two fin backs. Employed in the rig-
ging and so ends this day.

Thursday June 19

Lat 25.43 First part good breeze from S W. Ship beating to
Long 168.07 the W. Middle and Latter parts the same. Saw one
fin back. Employed in the rigging and so ends.
