

Tuesday July 1 - 1874

Lat 23.31 First part of this day good breeze from Long 173.55 the E by S. ship working to the E. Middle part the same Latter part squally. Saw one fin back and so ends this day.

Wednesday July 2

Lat 22.23 First part of this day moderate breeze from Long 175.07 the E by S. ship beating to the E heading NNE on one tack and SSE on the other. Saw one sail. Middle and Latter parts the same and so ends this day.

Thursday July 3

Lat 21.01 First part of this day strong breeze from Long 176.15 the ESE. ship heading NE by E. Middle and Latter parts the same. Saw nothing. so ends.

Friday July 4

Lat 19.25 First part of this day strong breeze from Long 177.52 the SE. ship steering NE. about 10 1/2 A.M. saw the Island of Kantar on the lee beam. Kept off heading N by W. about 4 P.M. luffed to on the port tack heading S by W. land 10 miles off. Started pork, and water so ends

Saturday July 5

First part of this day strong breeze from the SE Middle and Latter parts the same. At day light made sail and stood in to the land sent two boats ashore. got off yams, coconuts and figs and broom stuff. Left two natives that we got last year deserted. took three new natives called Tom, Dick and Mary and so ends this day.

Sunday July 6 - 1874

First part of this day strong breeze from the SE at day light sent in the larboard boat to see if they had got the run away, but they had not at 10 A.M. kept off heading NW under all sail. Middle and Latter parts the same. Several Leje Islands in sight and so ends this day.

Monday July 7 - 1874

First part of this day strong breeze from the E. ship beating along the reef. Middle and Latter parts the same. Broke out the slop chest and butter. Saw one sail and several islands. and so ends this day.

Tuesday July 8

First part of this day, blowing strong from the E. Working to the windward Middle and Latter parts the same. Started molasses so ends.

Wednesday July 9

Lat 16.07 First part of this day good breeze from the Long 177.26 ESE. ship working to the Eastward. Middle and Latter parts the same. Saw the land bearing ESE ten miles distant at sun down. Started water and so ends this day.

Thursday July 10

First part of this day good breeze from the ESE ship working to the Eastward. Middle part light baffling winds with rain. Latter part wind from the ESE with rain. Saw nothing. Employed in trimming ship. and so ends this day.
