

Wednesday July 23, 1874

Lat. 00.33° First part of this day good breeze from the S & E
 Long 177.27° At day light made sail steering S W. Middle
 and Latter parts the same. Saw the Island
 at day light. Repaired the main sail and
 misson top sail. Started water at sun down
 took in the light sails and courses and luff-
 ed too on the starboard tack heading NNE
 and so ends this day.

Thursday July 24

Lat. 00.22° First part of this day light breeze and
 Long 177.34° Calms. Ship working to the N. Middle and
 Latter parts the same. Saw nothing at sun
 down took in the light sails and so ends.

Friday July 25

Lat. 00.23° First part of this day good breeze from the
 Long 177.57° ESE Ship steering to the N and W. Bent a
 new Lower main top sail. about $2\frac{1}{2}$ P.M.
 raised a school of Black fish. lowered
 four boats. with out success. took the
 paddles out of all the boats and so ends.

Saturday July 26

Lat. 00.13° First part of this day good breeze from the
 Long 177.46° ENE. Ship steering WSW. Middle part steer-
 ing S W. Latter part SSE. Saw several schools
 of porpoise and one of grampse. Employed
 in repairing the lower main top sail.
 at sun down took in the light sails and so ends.

Sunday July 27

Lat. 00.20° First part of this day good breeze from
 Long 177.46° the ENE Ship on the port tack heading S & E
 Middle and Latter parts steering S by W
 at day light saw a school of Blackfish
 lowered two boats but did not fasten so ends.

Monday July 28, 1874

Lat. 1.00° First part of this day good breeze from the
 Long 177.41° E. Ship steering WSW. Middle part the same
 Latter part strong breeze with rain squalls
 saw a school of Blackfish just before dark
 lowered four boats with out success.
 Employed in repairing the fore sail. cut-
 off the upper part and put the lower main
 top sail on and so ends this day.

Tuesday July 29

Lat. 1.15° First part of this day good breeze from the
 Long 176.23° E. Ship steering WSW. Middle and Latter
 parts the same about 2 P.M. saw Byron's
 Island. finished the fore sail and bent it.
 started water and so ends.

Wednesday July 30

First part of this day good breeze from
 the E. at day light stood down by Byron's
 Island was boarded by the natives got
 some coconuts and broom stuff. Middle
 parts steering W. about 4 P.M. was boarded
 by the natives from Peue Island. Latter part
 ship on the wind heading N by W. and so ends.

Thursday July 31

Lat. 00.11° First part of this day good breeze from
 Long 175.20° the ENE. Ship on the port tack heading N by E
 & W. Middle and Latter parts the same.
 Saw one fin back and a school of grampse
 Employed in making spun yarn. Carpenter
 fixing the after hatch way and so end this
 day.
