

Wednesday Sept 10 1874

First part of this day good breeze from the ENE. Ship working to the E. Middle and Latter parts the same. Saw one fin back and pleasant Island. Started water and flour. Employed making spun yarn and painting the iron work and so ends.

Thursday Sept 11

First part of this day good breeze and fine weather stood in to Pleasant Island. was visited by several canoes. at noon sent the larboard boat ashore. got about 20 hogs and 1000 Cocovanuts and other trade so ends.

Friday Sept 12

First part of this day light breeze. Ship trying to beat up to the Island. Middle and Latter parts the same. was visited by one canoe. got 6 hogs and other trade. at sun down land 10 miles distant bearing E so ends.

Saturday Sept 13

First part of this day good breeze from the ESE got up to the Island and sent the boat in got off 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ cords of wood and some hogs and other trade. at sun down stood out heading SSW and so ends this day.

Sunday Sept 14

First part of this day good breeze from the E by N. Ship working to the E. Middle part steering N. Latter part on the wind. Saw Pleasant Island bearing N by E. distant 12 miles. at sun down took in the light sails and so ends this day.

Monday Sept 15 1874

First part of this day good breeze from the E by N. Ship beating to the E. Middle and Latter parts the same. Saw one fin back. Started water. Wet hold. Employed cold tanning the iron work and so ends this day.

Tuesday Sept 16

First part of this day good breeze from the NE by E. Ship on port tack heading ESE. Middle and Latter parts the same. Saw porpoise. Employed in painting iron work so ends.

Wednesday Sept 17

First part of this day light breeze and calms. Ship on the port tack heading ESE with frequent rain squalls. Repaired fore top mast stay sail. Middle and Latter parts the same. and so ends this day.

Thursday Sept 18

First part of this day light breeze from the NE by E. Ship heading ESE. Middle and Latter parts the same. Saw porpoise. Employed in the rigging and painting iron work, and so ends this day.

Friday Sept 19

First part of this day moderate breeze from the NE by E. Ship working to the E Middle and Latter parts the same. Saw nothing and so ends this day.

Saturday Sept 20

First part good breeze from the NNE. Ship steering S by W. Middle and Latter parts the same. Wet hold. Set up the main top mast rigging. Saw porpoise and so ends this day.
