

Monday Oct 13-1874

Lat 26.03 First part of this day light breeze from the ENE. Middle and Latter parts the same Ship working to the S. and E. Saw one sail Repaired the lower fore top sail at sun down took in the light sails and courses and so ends this day.

Tuesday Oct 14

Lat 26.19 First part of this day light breeze and Long 167.56 Calms. Middle part the same. Latter part light breeze from the N by E. Ship working to the E. Saw porpoises. Employed in the rigging, and so ends this day.

Wednesday Oct 15

Lat 26.33 First part of this day light breeze from the E Long 167.42 Ship working to the E. Middle and Latter parts the same. Saw nothing and so ends.

Thursday Oct 16

Lat 27.22 First part of this day light breeze and calms Long 167.28 Ship heading to the S and E. Middle and Latter parts the same. Saw fin backs. Employed in the rigging. Washed ship. at sun down took in the light sails and main sail and so ends.

Friday Oct 17

Lat 27.50 First part of this day light breeze from the E Long 168.18 Middle and Latter parts strong breeze took in the light sails and put one reef in the upper top sails. Saw hump backs and jumpers. at sun down took in the upper top sails and courses and set the storm sails ship working to the E. and so ends this day.

Saturday Oct 18-1874

Lat 28.00 First part of this day strong breeze from the ESE. Ship working to S. and E. Middle and Latter parts the same. Saw fin backs. Rove new jib sheets. Met hold. at sun down took in sail and set the storm sails and so ends.

Sunday Oct 19

Lat 28.40 First part of this day strong breeze from the Long 168.53 SE. Ship working S. Middle and Latter parts the same. Saw fin backs. Repaired the fore sail and so ends.

Monday Oct 20

Lat 28.35 First part of this day strong breeze from Long 168.42 the SSE. Ship beating to the S. and E. Middle and Latter parts moderate. Saw hump backs and Norfolk Island. took in the starboard boat. Carpenter repairing her. started water the land bore at sun down distance 25 miles. Oliver De Burge returned to duty and so ends.

Tuesday Oct 21

First part of this day light breeze from the SSE at day light was close into the land. Middle part beating up to the town Latter part the Capt. and went ashore and returned at sun down. stood out to the Eastward, saw large numbers of hump backs and so ends this day.

Wednesday Oct 22

First part light breeze about 10 A.M. the Captain and family went ashore, stood down to the watering place and got a raft of water Latter part stood it down, and stood out to the S.W. Saw plenty hump backs and so ends this day.
