

Sunday Nov 2 - 1874

Lat 31.06 First part of this day strong breeze from the S.W. Ship on the starboard tack heading to the S. and E. Middle and Latter parts the same. Saw nothing and so ends this day.

Monday Nov 3

Lat 32.25 First part of this day light breeze from the S. Ship heading E.S.E. Middle part the same Latter part calm. Saw one sail supposed to be a English Whaler. Repaired the spanker and painted the starboard boat. at sun down shortened sail. Started flour. and so ends this day.

Tuesday Nov 4

Lat 32.39 First part of this day strong breeze from the N.W. Ship heading N.W. Middle and Latter parts the same. Saw one sail. Employed in repairing the main sail and so ends this day.

Wednesday Nov 5

Lat 33.27 First part of this day strong breeze from the N.W. Ship on the port tack heading N.W. Middle part the same. Latter part moderating. Finished the main sail and bent it. Saw nothing and so ends this day.

Thursday Nov 6

Lat 33.45 First part of this day strong breeze from the N.W. with thick weather. Ship on the starboard tack heading W by S. Middle and Latter parts the same. Saw nothing. Repaired the main gallant sail. at sun down took in sail and so ends this day.

Friday Nov 7 - 1874

Lat 34.08 First part of this day strong breeze from the N.E. Ship steering W by S. Middle and Latter parts light breeze. Bent the main gallant sail. started water and coffee. Set up the Mizzen rigging and so ends this day.

Saturday Nov 8

First part of this day light breeze from the E. Ship steering N.W. by W. Middle part wind from the N. blowing strong with rain took in sail Latter part wind from the E. Saw two fin backs. Started molasses and so ends this day.

Sunday Nov 9

Lat 32.32 First part of this day light breeze from the E. Ship steering N.W. and W.N.W. Middle and Latter parts the same. Saw nothing. at sun down took in sail to lower top sail and so ends this day.

Monday Nov 10

First part of this day blowing a moderate gale from the N.W. with rain and fog. Middle part the wind hauled to the S.W. and blowing strong. Latter part the same. Ship under short sail. Saw one sail and so ends this day.

Tuesday Nov 11

Lat 32.27 First part of this day fresh gale from the S.W. Ship on the port tack. Middle and Latter parts the same. turned up the starboard boat and so ends.

Wednesday Nov 12

First part of this day strong breeze from the S. at day made sail and kept off steering N by E at 8 A.M. Saw Lord Howe's Island by the two on port tack. Middle and Latter parts the same.
