

Friday Feb 13-1875

Lat 31.50 First part of this day light air and calm.
Long 177.22 Ship working to the S. and E. middle and
Latter part the same. Repaired the fore
sail. Saw grampus, at sun down shortened
sail, and so ends this day.

Saturday Feb 14

32.48 First part of this day strong breeze from
Long 178.58 the E. ship on the port tack heading S by E
middle and Latter part the same. finished
the fore sail. Started water. Wet hold. at sun
down shortened sail and so ends this day.

Sunday Feb 15

Lat 33.02 First part of this day moderate breeze from
Long 179.26 the N. ship working to the E. middle and Latter
part light air and calm. Saw two sails at
sun down shortened sail and so ends this day.

Monday Feb 16

Lat 33.00 First part of this day moderate breeze from
the N. ship steering E. middle and Latter part
strong breeze with rain and fog. at noon hauled
to the wind N.N.W. took out the starboard
pump and repaired it. made a new pump
coat. Saw one sail. at sun down took in all
sail to lower main top sail and so ends.

Tuesday Feb 17

Lat 31.50 First part of this day moderate breeze from
Long the N. ship on the port tack heading N by W
middle and Latter part the same. Saw no-
thing. Employed in black smithing. at sun
down shortened sail and so ends this day.

Wednesday Feb 18-1875

Lat 31.24 First part of this day good breeze from the
Long 178.30 N. middle and Latter part the same. Saw
two sails. Employed in cold tarring the iron
work out side of the ship. at dark spoke
the Bark Splendid Capt. Mellen. at sun
down shortened sail and so ends this day.

Thursday Feb 19

Lat 31.37 First part of this day moderate breeze
Long 178.58 from the N. ship working to the N. and W.
middle and Latter part wind from the
W. ship steering N by W. about 2 P.M.
saw French Rock and one sail. filled
about 20 barrels of cask in the afterhold
with salt water. at sun down took in
sail the Rock bearing N by W distance
8 miles and so ends this day.

Friday Feb 20

Lat 31.18 First part of this day moderate breeze
from the S.E. at day light made sail
steering W by S. middle and Latter part
the same. Saw two sails and French Rock
at sun down shortened sail and luffed
two on the port tack and so ends this day.

Saturday Feb 21

Lat 31.40 First part of this day blowing a gale from
Long 178.15 the E. middle and Latter part the same
Saw nothing ship heading to the S.W. and so ends.

Sunday Feb 22

Lat 31.05 First part of this day strong breeze from the
Long 180.03 S.E. ship steering N.E. middle and Latter part
the same. Saw two sails at sun down took
in sails and wore ship heading N.W. and
so ends this day.
