

Friday March 6-1874

First part of this day light breeze from the NE. ship steering NE. Middle and Latter parts the same. Saw nothing. still setting up shooks and so ends.

Saturday March 7

First part of this day light breeze from the E. with rain and fog. ship working to the S. and E. Saw one sail. Middle and Latter parts the same. at sun down saw the land bearing S. about 40 miles off washed ship and so end this day.

Sunday March 8

First part of this day breeze from the E. at day light saw Cape Bun. and several sails about 4 P.M. dropped anchor in Russell Bay of Islands in 8 fathoms with a scope of 45 fathoms. Barks Hunter and Lagoda in port sent the larboard boat ashore after letters and so ends this day.

Monday March 9

This day fine weather and light breeze from the E. Washed ship. sent a raft of cask ashore. Broke out shooks. Cooper setting them up. and so ends this day.

Tuesday March 10

First part of this day fine weather got off a raft of water and stowed it and commenced to paint ship. but it soon came on to rain and so ends this day.

Wednesday March 11

First part of this strong breeze from the E with rain. Employed in filling water. middle and latter parts the same.

Thursday March 12-1875

First part of this day light breeze from the E. middle and latter parts the same. Employed in filling water and painting ship. Bark Atlantic Capt. Brown arrived and so ends.

Friday March 13

First part of this day light breeze from the E with rain. Middle and Latter parts the same. Employed in filling and rafting water and stowing down.

Saturday March 14

First part of this day good breeze and fine weather. Middle and Latter parts the same. Employed in painting the ship and filling water and so ends.

Sunday March 15

First part of this day fine weather and light breeze from the N. middle and latter parts the same. part of the crew ashore at dark all returned and so ends this day.

Monday March 16

First part of this day fine weather and light breeze from the N. Middle and Latter parts the same. finished painting. got off a raft of water and stowed it. Starboard watch ashore on liberty. all returned so ends.

Tuesday March 17

First part of this day fine weather and good breeze. Middle and Latter parts the same. Received 3 tone Bread and 3 tone of flour. 3 tone potatoes. Sugar. Butter. Beans. and other stores per steamer from Auckland. Larboard watch ashore on liberty. all returned and so ends this day.
