

Wednesday June 3-1875

Lat 25.06³ First part of this day moderate breeze
Long 174.13⁷ from the S.W. ship steering NNE. Middle
and Latter parts the same. Saw nothing
Repaired the jib and so ends this day.

Thursday June 4

Lat 23.21³ First part of this day good breeze from
Long 172.37⁷ the S.W. ship steering NNE. Middle and
Latter parts the same. Saw one fin back
started water and so ends this day.

Friday June 5

Lat 22.04³ First part of this day good breeze
Long 171.45⁷ from the S.E. ship heading NNE. Middle
and Latter parts the same. Saw one fin
back. Repaired the fly jib and so ends.

Saturday June 6

Lat 20.10³ First part of this day light breeze from
Long 171.11⁷ the S.E. ship heading NNE. Middle and
Latter parts the same. Saw several hump
backs. Repaired the main sail. Wet
hold and so ends this day.

Sunday June 7

Lat 18.33³ First part of this day good breeze
Long 170.33⁷ from the S.E. ship heading from N.E. NNE
middle part the same Latter part frequent
rain squalls. Saw several hump backs
and so ends this day.

Monday June 8

First part of this day good breeze from the
E. ship steering NNW. Middle and Latter
parts the same. Saw nothing and so ends.

Tuesday June 9-1875

First part of this day light breeze from the
NE. ship steering NW by N. Saw nothing. Middle
and Latter parts the same and so ends.

Wednesday June 10

First part of this day good breeze from
the E. ship steering NW by N. Middle part
raised the Island of Latter part
run down and luffed of the entrance to
the harbor. Shortened sail and so ends.

Thursday June 11

First part of this day good breeze from
the E.E. at day light made sail and
beat into the harbor. anchored about noon
in 26 fathoms with 15 fathoms of chain
out and about 3 miles from the principle
town. in company with the Brig Nelson and
and Bark Malthe of Auckland formerly
of New Bedford and so ends this day.

Friday June 12

These 24 hours fine weather and light
breeze. Employed in filling a raft of
water. and trading with the natives
for yams. Part of the crew ashore night
until 10 O'clock and so ends this day.

Saturday June 13

These 24 hours fine weather and good breeze
from the E. got off a raft of water and stow-
ed it. Bought stuff of the natives and so ends.

Sunday June 14

These 24 hours fine weather and light wind
Sent part of the crew ashore and all returned
and so ends this day.
