

Thursday June 25-1875

Lat 16.41 First part of this day good breeze
Long 174.05 and frequent rain squalls. Ship on the
starboard tack heading N. middle and
Latter parts the same. Saw one sail. re-
paired the fly jib. still cleaning the
cable and so ends this day.

Friday June 26

Lat 15.40 First part of this day baffling winds
Long 174.25 from the N. and E. Ship beating to the E
middle and Latter parts the same. Weather
thick and frequent rain squalls. Saw
nothing. Repaired the main gallant sail
still cleaning the chain. and so ends this day.

Saturday June 27

First part of this day moderate breeze
from the N. Ship working to the NE.
middle part the same. Latter part wind
from the SE. Ship steering NNE. Saw no-
thing. Wet hold. and so ends this day.

Sunday June 28

Lat 13.41 First part of this day light breeze from
Long 173.56 the NE. Ship steering NNW. middle and Latter
parts the same. Saw nothing and so ends.

Monday June 29

Lat 12.40 First part of this day moderate breeze from
Long 173.34 the SE. with frequent rain squalls. middle
and Latter parts the same. Saw nothing
Ship steering NNE. Still cleaning and oiling
the chain. Rove new main gallant buntline
and so ends this day.

Tuesday June 30. 1875

First part of this day good breeze from the
SE. Ship steering NNE. Weather fine. middle
part the same. Latter part. Wind ENE
Weather thick and heavy rain. Still cleaning
the chain and so ends this day.

Wednesday July 1

First part of this day moderate breeze
from the ENE. Ship heading NNW. Weather
thick and a heavy rain storm. middle
part the the same. Latter part light breeze
from the S. Ship steering NNE. Weather fine
Saw nothing. Started beef (5 1/4) barrels.
Repaired the fly jib and so ends this day.

Thursday July 2

Lat 9.18 First part of this day light breeze from
Long 173.26 the NE. Ship on the starboard tack heading
N. Weather squally. middle and Latter parts
the same. Still cleaning the chain. Saw one
fin back and so ends this day.

Friday July 3

Lat 8.18 First part of this day light baffling winds
Long 173.56 Ship working to the N. Weather thick and
rainy. Saw nothing. middle and Latter
parts the same. Started water. and so ends.

Saturday July 4

First part of this day moderate breeze
from the NE. Ship on the starboard tack
heading NNW. middle and Latter parts
strong breeze from the SE. Ship heading NNE
at sun down. took in the light sails and
main sail and so ends this day.
