

Sunday July 5-1875

Lat 5.25¹ First part of this day good breeze from
Long 173.40¹ the S.E. Ship steering N by E. middle and
Latter parts the same. about 11 A.M. raised
a reef. that is, ^{not} laid down on no chart
at sun down shortened sail. and stood
on opposite tacks during the night
and so ends this day.

Monday July 6

Lat 4.37³ First part of this day good breeze from
Long 173.46¹ the N.E. middle and Latter parts the
same. Weather fine. about 7¹/₂ A.M. John
Vera raised a school of sperm whales
going to the windward. lowered three
boats with out success. never saw
the whales out of the boats. beat to the
E during the night. and so ends.

Tuesday July 7

Lat 4.52¹ First part of this day light air and
Long 173.28¹ Calm. middle and Latter parts the
same. Saw nothing. Employed in taking
wood from between decks and putting
it in the lower hold. Started water &
and flour and so ends this day.

Wednesday July 8

First part of this day light air and
Calm. middle part the same. Latter
part good breeze from the S.E. Ship steer-
ing N.W. Saw one fin back and a school
of grampus. Painted the waist boat.
Employed in making spun yarn and
working in the rigging and so ends this day.

Thursday July 9-1875

First part of this day good breeze from
the S.E. Ship heading N by E. middle and
Latter parts the same. Saw two fin backs
Weather fine. Employed in making spun
yarn. and so ends this day.

Friday July 10

First part of this day moderate breeze
and fine weather from the S.E. Ship heading
to the N. middle and Latter parts the same
Saw nothing. Employed in making spun
yarn and so ends this day.

Saturday July 11

First part of this day good breeze from the
E. Ship heading the N. middle part shorten
sail and layed with the fore yard aback
all night. Latter part made sail and kept
off steering N.W. Wet-Hold and so ends.

Sunday July 12

First part of this day good breeze and
fine weather Ship steering S.W. Wind E.N.E.
middle and Latter parts the same. Saw no-
thing and so ends this day.

Monday July 13

First part of this day fine weather and
light breeze. Ship steering to the Westward
middle and Latter parts the same. About
noon raised Bakers Island. about 4 P.M.
sent a boat ashore after papers. Saw one
Bark laying to anchor. at sun down took
in the light sails. Repaired the main gal-
lant sail. and so ends this day.
