

Wednesday Sept-2-1875

First part of this day blowing a gale NNE. Weather thick. Ship steering E by N middle part the same. Latter part the wind hauled into the SW with main brace light breezes and heavy rain. Saw several hump backs and one sail heading to the NW. Peter Enos improving and so ends.

Thursday Sept-3

First part of this day strong breezes from the SW. Weather fine. Ship steering E by N. middle and latter parts wind light. Employed in setting up the main rigging again. Repaired the upper main top sail. Saw nothing and so ends.

Friday Sept-4

Lat-27.38 Long 163.48 First part of this day moderate breezes from the SW. Weather fine. Ship steering NE by E. middle and latter parts the same. Saw several hump backs. Repaired the jib and fly jib and so ends.

Saturday Sept-5

Lat-26.45 Long 164.29 First part of this day moderate breezes from the SW. fine weather. Ship steering NE by E. middle and latter parts the same. Saw hump backs. Wet hold. Peter Enos better and so ends.

Sunday Sept-6

Lat-26.01 Long 168.17 First part of this day blowing a fresh gale from the SW. Ship steering ENE. middle part steering E by N. Latter part took in all sail except the lower main top sail and fore stay sail and luffed two on the port tack heading NW. and so ends.

Monday Sept-7

Lat-26.34 Long 169.01 First part of this day strong breezes from the SW. Weather good. Ship steering ENE middle and latter parts the same. Repaired the main top mast spring stay. Saw nothing and so ends this day.

Tuesday Sept-8

Lat-25.26 Long 171.48 First part of this day moderate breezes from the SSE. Weather fine. Ship steering E by N. middle and latter parts on the wind heading E. Saw porpoises. Started water. Repaired the main stop mast stay sail. Rove new main gallant sheets and so ends.

Wednesday Sept-9

Lat-25.25 Long 172.49 First part of this day light air and calms. Weather fine. middle and latter parts light breezes from the S. Ship heading ESE. Saw nothing. Repaired the fore sail started bread. Opened the slop chest and so ends this day.

Thursday Sept-10

First part of this day good breezes from the NNE. Ship on the port tack heading E. Weather fine. middle and latter parts the same. Employed coopersing the bread and flour. Captain blacksmithing. Saw nothing and so ends this day.

Friday Sept-11

Lat-26.04 Long 173.44 First part of this day light air and calms middle and latter parts the same. Weather fine. Saw nothing. Employed in breaking out the after hold. Captain blacksmithing. Peter Enos better and so ends this day.
