

Thursday Nov 12-1875

First part of this day blowing a gale from the S.W. Middle and Latter parts the same. Saw fin backs, Carpenter planing the stern, and so ends this day.

Friday Nov 13

Lat 34.38° Long 160.00 First part of this day blowing a gale from the E. Ship heading to the S. Weather thick and rainy. Middle and Latter parts moderating. Saw one sail bound to the W. and a school of porpoise and one fin back and so ends this day.

Saturday Nov 14

Lat 35.20 Long 159.59 First part of this day light breezes from the E. Weather hazy. Ship steering S by W. middle and Latter parts calm. Saw one fin back and a school of porpoise. Met hold. Caught a porpoise and so ends.

Sunday Nov 15

Lat 35.40° Long 158.54 First part of this day moderate breezes from the S.E. Weather fine. Ship steering to the N.W. middle and Latter parts the same. Saw large numbers of porpoises caught two at sun down shortened sail and luffed two and so ends this day.

Monday Nov 16

Lat 34.29° Long 158.47 First part of this day strong breezes from the S.E. Weather fine. Ship steering N.W. middle and Latter parts the same. Saw one fin back and one sail and large numbers of porpoises. Repaired the main gallant sail and main top sail. At sun down shortened sail and so ends this day.

Tuesday Nov 17-1875

Lat 33.29° Long 158.14 First part of this day light breezes from the S.W. Ship steering N.W. Weather fine. middle parts calm. Latter part wind from the N. Ship on the wind heading W. started water. Saw porpoises and fumpers and so ends this day.

Wednesday Nov 18

First part of this day light winds from the N. Ship steering to the E. middle and Latter parts wind from the W and S.W. with heavy rain squalls. Saw nothing and so ends this day.

Thursday Nov 19

First part of this day strong breezes from the S. Weather good. The leach rope on the fore sail parted and tore the sail all to nothing. Bent the new one. middle part the same. Latter part light breezes ship under all sail. Saw a school of porpoises. Employed in ripping up the old fore sail and so ends this day.

Friday Nov 20

First part of this day strong breezes from the W. Weather good. Ship steering E by N. middle and Latter parts the same. Saw nothing. Repaired the main sail. and so ends this day.

Saturday Nov 21

Lat 33.00° Long 156.46 First part of this day strong breezes from the N.W. Weather good. Ship steering N.E. middle and Latter parts the same. Saw nothing. Met hold and started water and so ends.
