

Lat 33.32^S
Long 178.20^E

Sunday Nov 22 - 1875

First part of this day light breezes from the S.E. Weather fine. Ship steering N.E. middle and latter parts the same. Saw several fin backs at sun down shortened sail and so ends this day.

Monday Nov 23

First part of this day good breezes from the N.W. by N. Weather good. Ship heading to the N.E. middle part the same. Latter part wind from the N backed ship. At sun down shortened sail. Employed in making spun yarn. Saw nothing and so ends this day.

Tuesday Nov 24

First part of this day strong breezes from the N.W. Weather good. Saw one fin back. Ship heading to the N.W. middle and latter parts the same. At sun down shortened sail so ends.

Wednesday Nov 25

First part of this day light breezes from the S.W. Ship heading to the N.W. Weather fine. Saw nothing. Employed in making spun yarn middle and latter parts the same so ends.

Thursday Nov 26

First part of this day light air and calm middle part moderate breezes from the S.W. Weather fine. Latter parts strong breezes. Took in the light sails. Ship working to the N. Saw one fin back. Repaired the flying jib and unbent the main gallant ably sail. Employed in making spun yarn. At sun down took in all sail except lower main top sail and set the storm sails and so ends this day.

Friday Nov 27 - 1875

Lat 31.55^S
Long 169.17^E

First part of this day blowing a moderate gale from the S.W. with rain. middle part clear. Latter part blowing on. Ship on the port tack heading N.W. under short sail. Saw nothing and so ends this day.

Saturday Nov 28

Lat 30.45^S
Long 170.04^E

First part of this day blowing a gale from the N. Ship on the port tack heading to the N. middle part tried to run steering E. but soon luffed to the wind. Ship under lower main top sail. Latter part the same. started water, pork, flour, wet hold and so ends this day.

Sunday Nov 29

Lat 30.45^S
Long 171.06^E

First part of this day strong breezes from the S. Weather squally. steering E by S middle and latter parts the same. Saw nothing. At sun down shortened sail and luffed to and so ends this day.

Monday Nov 30

Lat 31.05^S
Long 172.57^E

First part of this day strong breezes from the S. Weather squally. steering E by S middle and latter parts the same. Saw a school of porpoise. Repaired the main spencer and so ends this day.

Tuesday Dec 1

Lat 31.25^S
Long 174.40^E

First part of this day moderate breezes from the N. Weather fine. Ship steering E by S middle and latter parts the same. Saw nothing. painted the stern. Employed generally and so ends this day.
