First part of this day good breeze from the N. Weather thick. Ship working to the N. Saw nothing. Middle and latter parts the same. Wet-hold. Started flour. Repaired the main top sail and so ends this day.

Sunday Dec 13

First part of this day strong breeze from the E. Weather thick with rain. Ship heading N. middle and latter parts blowing a gale. Ship under storm sails, and so ends.

Monday Dec 14

Lat 31.43³ First part of this day moderate breeze from the N. Weather thick fog, with rain. Saw nothing. Middle and latter parts the same. Employed generally. Saw nothing. Ship working to the E. and so ends.

Tuesday Dec 15

First part of this day light breeze from the N. Ship heading to the E. Weather thick. Saw nothing. Middle and latter parts the same. Rove one new fore clue gannet (2 1/4) inch rope. Started butter and pork at sun down shortened sail and so ends.

Wednesday Dec 16

First part of this day moderate breeze from the N. Weather thick. Ship working to the N. Saw nothing. Middle and latter parts the same. Started water, at sun down shortened sail. Employed in the rigging and so ends this day.

Thursday Dec 17-1875

First part of this day light breeze from the N. Weather fine. Ship working to the N. Saw nothing. Middle and latter parts the same. Employed in taring the back stays and so ends this day.

Friday Dec 18

First part of this day light air and calm. Weather fine. Middle and latter parts light breeze from the N. Ship steering S by W. Saw nothing. Captain blacksmithing and so ends.

Saturday Dec 19

Lat 32.38³ First part of this day light breeze from the NE. Weather fine. Ship steering N S W. Middle and latter parts the same. Saw nothing. Repaired the fore gallant sail. Wet-hold, and so ends this day.
Long 177.24²

Sunday Dec 20

First part of this day light breeze from the NE. Weather fine. Ship steering S S W. Middle and latter parts the same. Saw juncos. at sun down look in the light sails and courses and so ends this day.

Monday Dec 21

First part of this day light breeze from the NE. Weather fine. Ship steering S S W. Middle and latter parts the same. Saw grampus. Broke out between decks and took a look at the lumber rack and so ends this day.

Tuesday Dec 22

First part of this day light breeze from the NE. Weather fine. Ship steering S S W. Middle and latter parts the same. Saw nothing. Employed generally at sun down shortened sail and so ends this day.
