

Tuesday Jan 12-1876

Lat 31-13, First part of this day good breeze from
Long 177-04 the S. Weather fine. Ship working to N and
E. about day light saw French Rock
middle and Latter parts the same
at sun down wore ship and shortened
sail and so ends this day.

Wednesday Jan 13

Lat 31-13 First part of this day good breeze S
Long 177-11 ship working to the N. middle and Latter
parts the same. Weather fine. Saw French
Rock. at sun down shortened sail. Employed
mended the spanker and so ends.

Thursday Jan 14

Lat 31-12 First part of this day good breeze
Long 180-06 from the E. Ship steering N N W. middle and
Latter parts steering S W. Saw a school
of Black fish. Repaired the main sail
and so ends this day.

Friday Jan 15

Lat 31-26 First part of this day good breeze
Long 178-55 from the E. Weather cloudy. Ship steering
N. middle and Latter parts the same
saw a school of porpoises. Started water
and so ends this day.

Saturday Jan 16

Lat 31-25 First part of this day light breeze from the
Long 178-47 E. Weather fine. Ship working to the S E
saw nothing. Wet Hold. middle and
Latter parts the same and so ends

Sunday Jan 17-1876

Lat 32-05 First part of this day light air and
Long 178-54 Calms. Weather fine. Saw nothing. middle
and Latter parts the same. at sun down
shortened sail and so ends this day.

Monday Jan 18

Lat 32-33 First part of this day light breeze from
Long 178-47 the E. Weather fine. Saw nothing. Ship work-
ing to the S. and E. Employed generally.
middle and Latter parts the same and
so ends this day.

Tuesday Jan 19

Lat 33-25 First part of this day moderate breeze from
Long 178-07 the N W. Weather fine. Ship steering to the S E
middle part the same. Latter part on the
wind heading N E. about quarter to one
Demingo de Cruise raised one sperm whale
going to the N. quick lowered four boats
with out success. never saw the whale
from the boats. at sun down shortened sail
and so ends this day.

Wednesday Jan 20

Lat 33-43 First part of this day moderate breeze
from the S E. Weather thick with rain
saw nothing. middle and Latter parts the
same. started flour and so ends this day.

Thursday Jan 21

Lat 33-37 First part of this day light breeze from the
Long 178-45 N W. Weather thick and rainy. about 8 A.M.
Demingo Silva raised a school of sperm whales
going N E. lowered 4 boats and the bow boat
struck. took the whale along side about noon
commenced to cut, got the head off and body
in about 7 P.M. and so ends this day.
