

Friday Feb 12-1876

Lat 33.27 First part of this day light breeze from the
Long 179.25 E. Ship steering to the S. middle and latter
parts the same. At day light commenced
to stow down in the fore peak finished about
dark stowed down 145 barrels. Saw one
sail. at dark shortened sail and so ends.

Saturday Feb 13

First part of this day light breeze from the
E. Weather fine. about 9 A.M. spoke ship
James Arnold. middle part the same. latter
part strong breeze and squally and so ends

Sunday Feb 14

Lat 33.00 First part of this day light breeze from the
Long 179.46 S.W. Weather fine. Ship steering N by W. middle
and latter parts the same. Saw two sails
and so ends this day.

Monday Feb 15

First part of this day light breeze from
the S. Weather good. Ship steering to the N.
middle and latter parts the same. Saw
three sails at 5 P.M. Spoke ship Niger.
Capt. Hallett. 16 months out 1400 all
told and so ends this day.

Tuesday Feb 16

Lat 32.15 First part of this day good breeze from
Long 179.45 the S. Weather good. Ship steering to the N.E.
middle and latter parts the same. Saw
two sails. Employed generally. Captain
Blacksmithing and so ends this day.

Wednesday Feb 17-1876

Lat 33.50 First part of this day good breeze from the
Long 178.46 N.E. Weather fine. Ship working to the South
middle and latter parts the same. Saw one
sail. Employed in scraping bone at sun
down shortened sail and so ends this day.

Thursday Feb 18

Lat 33.35 First part of this day good breeze from the
Long 178.00 N.W. Weather good. Ship working to the N.
middle and latter parts the same. Employed
in making spun yarn. about 1 P.M. spoke
Bark Coral Capt. Marvin 2000 all told
Captain Blacksmithing. and so ends

Friday Feb 19

Lat 33.31 First part of this day good breeze from
Long 177.58 the N.W. Weather good. Ship working to the
S. middle and latter parts light breeze
and calms. Saw three sails. Bent a new
gibb. Employed in making spun yarn
and so ends this day.

Saturday Feb 20

Lat 34.08 First part of this day good breeze from
Long 177.22 the E.S.E. Weather fine. Middle and latter
parts the same. Saw three sails. Met hold
cut up the old gibb. Ship working to the
S.W. Employed in making spun yarn
and so ends this day.

Sunday Feb 21

First part of this day light breeze from
the E.S.E. Weather fine. Saw nothing. mid-
dle and latter parts the same. Ship work-
ing to the S.W. at sun down shortened
sail and so ends this day.
