

Tuesday April 19-1876.

First part of this day strong breeze from the N. Ship steering N^W middle and latter parts the same. finished boiling. Saw nothing and so ends this day.

Wednesday April 20

First part of this day strong breeze from the NE. Ship under short-sail. middle and latter parts the same. stowed down about 30 barrels in the after hold. Saw nothing and so ends this day.

Thursday April 21

First part of this day strong breeze from the NE. Ship under short-sail. at day light commenced to stow down. finished about 4 P.M. and kept off steering S.W. Saw nothing and so ends this day.

Friday April 22

First part of this day strong breeze from the NE. at 4 P.M. saw Cape Brett hauled aback until day light. at day light stood into the Bay of Islands. at noon came to anchor in 7 fathoms and 45 fathoms of chain out in company with the Gamelle. Logoda Niger and the Mary Francis. later the James Arnold arrived and so ends this day.

Saturday April 23

These 24 hours fine weather. Wind from the NE. Employed in getting the water back ashore and getting ready for freight. Broke out the after hold. and sold the tank and so ends this day.

Sunday April 24-1876

First part of this day fine weather. Wind NE middle and latter parts the same. part of the crew ashore. at sun down all returned and so ends this day.

Monday April 25

First part of this day fine weather. Wind NE middle and latter parts the same. About noon the James Arnold hauled alongside and we commenced to take freight in the after hold. and so ends this day.

Tuesday April 26

First part fine weather. Wind NE. still taking freight middle and latter parts the same. and so ends this day.

Wednesday April 27

First part of this day fine weather. Wind NE. Finished taking freight from the James Arnold. about 10 A.M. We took 48 Casks containing 261 Bbls. 12¹/₂ gallons. About dark ship Niger came along side and so ends.

Thursday April 28

First part of this day strong breeze from S.W. Employed in stowing the Niger oil in the between decks. Weather thick with heavy rain. middle and latter parts the same.

Friday April 29

First part fine weather. Wind NE. middle and latter parts the same. finished the Niger oil and she hauled away about 8 A.M. We took 243 Bbls and 20¹/₂ gallons and so ends this day.
