

Saturday April 30-1876

First-part of this day light breezes from the S.E. Weather squally. Middle and Latter parts the same. Got off the water and stowed it away between decks and so ends.

Sunday May 1

First-part of this day light breezes from the E. middle and latter parts the same Part of the crew ashore at sun down all returned and so ends.

Monday May 2

First-part of this day good breezes from the S.E. middle and latter parts the same Employed in painting. Sent the starboard watch on liberty and so ends this day.

Tuesday May 3

First-part of this day good breezes from the S.E. middle and latter parts the same Weather squally. Employed in painting Sent the port watch ashore on liberty Discharged three natives of New Zealand and so ends this day.

Wednesday May 4

First-part of this day good breezes from the S.E. middle and latter parts the same Employed in painting. got 1/2 ton of Bread from ashore and stowed it away. Bark Mary Frazier sailed for home and so ends.

Thursday May 5

First-part of this day good breezes from N.E. middle and latter parts the same finished painting out side the second Coat, and so ends this day.

Friday May 6-1876

First-part of this day good breezes from the N.E. Weather squally. Middle and latter parts the same. Employed in setting up and taring the head gear and so ends this day.

Saturday May 7

First-part of this day good breezes from the S.E. Weather squally. Middle and latter parts the same. Commenced to paint in side and the spars and so ends this day.

Sunday May 8

First-part of this day good breezes from the S.E. Weather squally. middle and latter parts the same. part of the crew ashore and so ends this day.

Monday May 9

First-part of this day good from the N.E. Weather squally. middle and latter parts the same. Trying to paint inside and the spars and so ends this day.

Tuesday May 10

First-part of this day good breezes from the S.E. middle and latter parts the same Put a new fid in the main top mast Employed in painting. Received by steamer from Auckland. 8 tuns of Beef. 1/4 ton flour. 2 ton potatoes. and one keg of Butter Starboard watch ashore on liberty so ends.

Wednesday May 11

First-part of this day. Weather good. middle and latter parts the same. Employed in painting and setting up and taring the rigging. Starboard watch ashore on liberty and so ends this day.
