

Monday May 23-1876

First part of this day strong breezes from the S.W. Weather squally with hail. Ship steering E. middle part the same. Latter part moderate. Wind N.W. Ship steering E. by S. under all sail. Employed generally and so ends this day.

Tuesday May 24

Lat 44.30^S First part of this day strong breezes from Long 137.40^W the S. Weather squally. Ship steering E. by S. middle and latter parts moderating. Ship under all sail. Saw nothing. Started water, and molasses, and so ends this day.

Wednesday May 25

Lat 46.05^S First part of this day moderate breezes from the W. Weather good. Ship steering E. by S. middle and latter parts the same. Saw nothing. Employed in making spun yarn. Repaired the main spencer and so ends this day.

Thursday May 26

First part of this day strong breezes from the N.W. Weather foggy. Ship steering E. middle and latter parts the same. Saw nothing. Employed generally. Started water and so ends this day.

Friday May 27

First part of this day strong breezes from the N.W. Weather thick and foggy. Ship steering E. middle and latter parts the same. Wind moderate. Saw nothing and so ends this day.

Saturday May 28-1876

Lat 47.00^S First part of this day moderate breezes from the N.W. Weather thick. Ship steering E. middle and latter parts the same. Saw nothing and so ends this day.

Sunday May 29

Lat 47.38^S First part of this day light breezes from Long 137.58^W the N.W. Weather thick. Ship steering E. middle part the same. Wind N.W. strong breezes. Latter part calm. Saw nothing and so ends.

Monday May 30

Lat 48.14^S First part of this day light airs from Long 136.34^W the N. Weather cloudy. Ship steering E. by N. middle and latter parts the same. Saw nothing and so ends this day.

Tuesday May 31

First part of this day moderate breezes from the N. Weather cloudy. Ship heading E. by N. middle and latter parts the same. Saw nothing and so ends this day.

Wednesday June 1

First part of this day blowing a strong gale from the S.E. Ship heading E. N.E. Weather cloudy. middle and latter parts the same. Bent a new main stay sail. Ship under storm sails and so ends this day.

Thursday June 2

Lat 47.17^S First part of this day light breezes from Long 132.05^W the N.W. Weather cloudy. Ship steering E. middle part wind N.W. Latter part W. Saw nothing. Started water and so ends.
