

Tuesday June 14-1876

Lat 55.12^S First part of this day light breezes from
Long 77.23^W the S. Weather clear. Ship steering E. mid-
dle part light air and calm. Latter part
good breeze from the W. to NW. with rain
and fog. Saw four sails working to the
N. and W. Started bread, oil, and beef
and so ends this day.

Wednesday June 15

First part of this day strong breezes
from the W. Weather cloudy. Ship steering
E. middle and Latter parts the same
at dark shortened sail. Saw nothing
and so ends this day.

Thursday June 16

First part of this day blowing a gale
from the NW. Weather thick. Ship steering
E. middle and Latter parts the same.
Saw one sail working to the W. at 4 P.M.
took in sail and hove too on the port-
tack heading N. and so ends this day.

Friday June 17

First part of this day strong breezes
from the NW. Ship on the port-tack
heading N. at 7 1/2 A.M. made sail and
kept off steering NE by E 1/2 E. middle and
Latter parts wind from the W. and moder-
ate. Saw nothing. Employed making
a new log line and so ends this day.

Saturday June 18

First part blowing a gale from the NW. Weather
thick. Ship steering NE by E. about 10 A.M. took in
all sail. and hove too on the port-tack. middle and
Latter part moderating at 3 P.M. kept off steering N.
by N. Saw nothing and so ends this day.

Sunday June 19. 1876

First part of this day moderate breezes
from the SW. Weather cloudy. no observation
Ship steering NE by N. middle and Latter
parts the same. Saw nothing. Started water
and so ends this day.

Monday June 20

Lat 53.50^S First part of this day light breezes from
Long 55.57^W the SW. Weather fine. Ship steering NE by N.
middle part the same. Latter part wind
SSW. steering NE by E 1/2 E. Saw nothing.
Sent the main Royal yard and sail aloft
and so ends this day.

Tuesday June 21

Lat 52.34^S First part of this day light breezes from the
Long 55.06^W SSW. Weather good. Ship steering N by E 1/2 E
middle part the same. Latter part wind
hauling from the SW. to NW. steering NNE
Saw one sail steering to the N. and E. Car-
penter repairing the bow boat. and so ends.

Wednesday June 22

Lat 50.32^S First part of this day good breezes from
Long 52.06^W the NW. Weather good. Ship heading NNE
to NE by N. middle and Latter parts the same.
Sent the main gallant stay sail. Carpenter
repairing waist boat. Saw nothing so ends.

Thursday June 23

Lat 47.54^S First part of this day strong breezes from the
Long 48.40^W N. Weather thick. Ship steering NE by N. mid-
dle and Latter parts wind from the SSW
and moderating. Saw nothing and so ends.
