

Tuesday July 5-1876

Lat 27.52^S First part strong breeze from the ENE with
Long 29.56^W rain. Middle and Latter parts wind from
the N.W. ship heading NE by N. Saw one sail
Repaired main top mast stay sail & so ends

Wednesday July 6

Lat 26.58^S First part strong breeze from W by N ship heading
Long 29.15^W NE. Weather fine. Saw several fin backs.
Employed generally. Middle and Latter parts
the same. and so ends this day.

Thursday July 7

Lat 24.25^S First part moderate breeze from N to N.W.
Long 29.33 ship working to the N. middle and Latter
parts the same. started water. Repaired
main gallant stay sail. made spun yarn
Saw one sail and exchanged signal. and
one fin back and so ends this day.

Friday July 8

Lat 22.41^S First part light breeze from N.W. ship work
Long 29.22^W ing to the NE. Middle and Latter parts light
air and calm. Saw one sail. Bent the sail
over and the best spanker. Rattling minnie
rigging. Started flour. and so ends.

Saturday July 9

Lat 21.48^S First part light breeze from N.W. heading from
Long 28.50^W NE by E to NE. Weather fine. Middle and
Latter parts the same. Saw two sails. Wet hold
Employed in the rigging. About 3 P.M spoke
the English Bark Fanny. 68 days from Peru
bound to Falmouth England. and so ends.

Sunday July 10

Lat 21.04^S First part light air and calm. Middle and Latter parts good
Long breeze from N.W. working to the N. Mr Fisher shot a fin back humped
and struck him and he sunk. Saw five sails and Finadale so ends

Monday July 11-1876

Lat 19.15^S First part good breeze from W. Weather fine
Long 29.13^W middle part took the trades. Latter part the
same. steering N by W. Saw three sails. Employed
rattling the rigging. and so ends this day.

Tuesday July 12

Lat 17.44^S First part moderate breeze from the S and S.E.
Long 29.10^W ship steering N by W. middle part the same.
Latter part wind hauled to NE. with frequent
squalls. Saw two sails. Employed in the rigging
and so ends this day.

Wednesday July 13

Lat 15.40^S First part moderate breeze breeze from the
Long 31.06^W S.E. steering N by W. middle part wind from
E to N. with rain. Latter part light air and
calm. Saw two sails. Still rattling the
rigging and so ends this day.

Thursday July 14

Lat 14.09^S First part moderate breeze from S by E. steering
Long 32.10^W N. middle part wind baffling. Latter part
from S.E. Weather good. Employed in the rigging
and cold tarring the chains. and so ends.

Friday July 15

Lat 11.45^S First part moderate breeze from S.E. steering
Long 33. N. middle part wind baffling. Latter part the
same. steering N by E. Saw nothing. Employed
in the rigging and so ends.

Saturday July 16

First part good breeze from S.E. Weather fine.
steering N by E. middle and Latter parts the
same. Saw nothing. Employed in the rigging
and cleaning and cold tarring the top sails
sheets. Wet hold and so ends.
