

Thursday July 28 1876

Lat 17.00^N First part strong trades well to the E
Master squally. Steering NW by N. middle
and latter parts the same. Saw
nothing. Employed in the rigging & ends

Friday July 29

Lat 17.30^N First part strong NE trades well to the E
Long 52.16 middle and latter parts moderate
steering NW by N. Weather squally. Em-
ployed in the rigging and cold tarring
the top sail sheets. Started beef and swede

Saturday July 30

Lat 17.59^N First part good breeze from NE. middle and
Long 54.22 latter parts the same. Weather good. Employ-
ed taring the rigging. Saw one sail. Not held.

Sunday July 31

Lat 22.06^N First part good breeze from E. middle and
Long 54.07 latter parts wind light. Weather squally.
Steering NW by N. and so ends.

Monday Aug 1

Lat 23.45^N First part good breeze from E & E. Weather fine
Long 57.15 steering NW by N. middle and latter parts the
same. Saw one sail. Employed washing ship
and taring the rigging. and so ends.

Tuesday Aug 2

Lat 25.35^N First part good breeze and fine weather
Long 57.26 steering NW by N. middle and latter parts the
same. Employed painting ship inside.
Saw one sail and so ends.

Wednesday Aug 3 1876

Lat 26.25^N First part light breeze from S. Steering NW
Long 60.22 Weather fine. middle part the same. Latter part
calm. Employed painting ship. Saw nothing & ends

Thursday Aug 4

Lat 27.00^N First part light breeze from S. Weather fine.
Long 61.14 steering NW by N. middle and latter parts the
same. Wind SW. Saw nothing. Painting ship
inside and so ends this day.

Friday Aug 5

Lat 28.30^N First part moderate breeze from SW. Weather
Long 62.12 good. heading NNW. Saw one sail. middle
and latter parts the same. Employed painting
the water ways and so ends.

Saturday Aug 6

Lat 29.56^N First part good breeze from S & W. heading
NW. middle and latter part wind backing
Weather squally. Started water and flour.
Not held. and so ends.

Sunday Aug 7

Lat 31.22^N First part light breeze from S by N. Weather
Long 65.56 good. heading NW by N. middle and latter
parts wind W. Ship working to the N and W.
Saw several sails. spoke the German Bark
Windstraut of Brake. Bound to Falmouth
England. and so ends.

Monday Aug 8

Lat 33.19^N First part light variable breezes and calm
Weather fine. working to the N. and N. mid-
dle and latter parts the same. Employed
painting ship inside. Saw several sails
and so ends.
