This day light breeze from the E ship on the wind heading NNE nothing been seen to day so ends.

Friday

June 17th

This day thick weather with light breeze from the ESE ship on the wind heading NE. nothing been seen to day so ends.

Saturday

June 18th

This day light breeze from the SE ship on the wind heading NE. about noon saw the land Greenland more ship heading S. saw one fin back and several birds so ends.

Sunday

June 19th

This day first part light breeze from the NE ship on the wind heading SE by E. middle and latter part strong breeze about 4 PM. took in Gallant sails and upper topsails. saw grampse and one seal also saw the land this morning so ends this day.

Monday

June 20th

This day light breeze from the N. ship on the wind heading NE. men employed in ships duty. saw several grampse. so ends this day.

Tuesday

June 21st 1881.

This day very light breeze from the N. ship steering E. weather hazy. no observation saw porpoises so ends this day.

Wednesday

June 22nd

This day light breeze from the SE ship stood on opposite tack nothing been seen except a few birds. so ends. weather thick no observation

Thursday

June 23rd

This day blowing strong from the East weather thick no observation ship on the starboard tack heading SSE. under short sail barometer at 5 PM. down to 29.10 and falling still saw fin back.

Friday

June 24th

This day weather more moderate wind from the ENE ship on the wind under short sail heading SE. saw several porpoises so ends this day.

Saturday

June 25th

This day blowing strong from the NW very bad sea on. ship under short sail steering SSE nothing been seen so ends.

Sunday

June 26th

This day blowing strong from the NW ship steering S by W. under short sail very bad sea on. saw nothing

Monday

June 27th

This day blowing to gale from the NW. first and middle part steering SSW. latter part on the wind heading SW. nothing been seen
