First part of this day strong breeze from the W. middle part the same latter part heavy rain squalls at day light commenced to cut in the head got it in cut up the junk and boiled the case ^{from} over board and put it in the tank got through about 5 o'clock got supper and set the watch saw one sail working to the East.

Monday July 11th

This day moderate breeze from the W N W. with very heavy swell. ship on the Starboard tack heading S W. employed boiling saw three sails and school of porpoises.

Tuesday July 12th

This day strong breeze from the W. ship on the port tack heading N W by N. employed boiling saw three sails, two sails passed us last night in the night. so ends this day. weather thick

Wednesday July 13th

This day strong breeze from the N S W ship on port tack heading N W finished boiling about 1 P.M. the whole turned up 97. lbs. saw two sails signalled a Dutch merchant-ship steering to the eastward, weather very thick saw fin back & porpoise,

Thursday July 14th 1881

This day first part strong breeze from the S W, middle and latter part more moderate ship on the wind heading W by N. saw one sail sulphur bottom and porpoise, so ends this day.

Friday July 15th

This day moderate breeze from the E. first part ship on the wind middle and latter part steering N W. employed stowing oil got it down about 5 o'clock saw four sails, so ends this day.

Saturday July 16th

This day strong breeze from the W. ship on the wind, about 10 A.M. spoke Bark Lagoda Capt Lewis. Capt & Mrs Brighton went on board found Capt Lewis sick been sick for six weeks with rheumatism. they have got 1800 lbs all sold, day ends with thick fog and rain.

Sunday July 17th

This day strong breeze from the W. first part on the wind middle and latter part steering East saw four sails one steamer. porpoises and fin back so ends.

Monday July 18th

This day strong breeze from the N W. first and middle part steering E by S. latter part on the wind saw fin back porpoises so ends,
