Wednesday Aug 10th
This day moderate breeze from the S.W. ship on the wind heading N.N.W. saw several sails and porpoises fimbriated. men employed in the rigging weather good so ends.

Long 39.21
Thursday Aug 11th
This day good breeze from the S.W. ship on the wind working to the N. saw five sails all merchantmen men employed in the rigging so ends.

Lat-42.18
Long 40.7
Friday Aug 12th
This day light breeze from the S.W. ship on the wind working to the N. weather thick and muggy. saw grampus and one sail covered the boats after supper to test their sailing. so ends.

Lat-42.19
Long 39.52
Saturday Aug 13th
This day moderate breeze from the S.W. ship on the wind on opposite tack, saw one sail so ends this day.

Lat-41.30
Long 39.8
Sunday Aug 14th
This day light breeze from the S.W. ship trying to get to the N. saw one sail and porpoises. weather good so ends this day.

Lat-40.48
Long 39.10
Monday Aug 15th
This day fine weather very light breeze from S.W. ship on the wind working to the N. saw several sails and grampus also a spar and turtle and some squid so ends.

Lat-40.16
Long 39.20
Tuesday Aug 16th 1881.
This day fine weather with very light breeze from the N. ship on the wind working to the S.W. saw two sails porpoise and caught a dolphin. men employed repairing old fore sail. so ends.

Lat-39.42
Long 39.24
Wednesday Aug 17th
This day light air and calm ship scarcely moves. saw killer porpoise and a large log. lowered a boat and caught fifteen dolphin around the log. finished repairing the old fore sail and bent it so ends this day.

Lat-39.7
Long 40.2
Thursday Aug 18th
This day moderate breeze from the N.N.W. ship on opposite tack looking hard for a whale but see none. weather squally. men employed doing ships duty. saw ten sails signalled a Dutch bark so ends this day.

Lat-39.36
Long 40.6
Friday Aug 19th
First part of this day light breeze from the S.W. ship on the wind middle and latter part nearly a calm ship steering N.N.W. saw three sails and porpoises. nothing new to write so ends this day.

Lat-39.32
Long 40.30
Saturday Aug 20th
This day moderate breeze from the N.N.W. ship on the wind heading N. saw several sails fimbriated and caught a porpoise at dark shortened sail so ends day.
