Wednesday

Aug 31st 1881

This day strong breeze from the NW ship steering E. saw one sail going the same way that we are. nothing more been seen except porpoises

Thursday

Sep 1st

This day light breeze from the NW ship steering E by N. weather squally at daylight saw the islands of Flores & Corvo. worked up towards the land looking for a whale but see none at 5 PM wore ship land astern. ship

Friday

Sep 2nd

This day strong breeze from the NW ship after breakfast sent a boat into Corvo to see if we could get some potatoes could not get but a bushel. after the boat returned kept off steering SE. saw the John & Minthrop Reinder and Ware laying off and on so ends this day.

Saturday

Sep 3rd

This day moderate breeze from the N ship cruising about the islands saw the islands of Fayal Pico, St George, Graciosa & Terceira. weather thick so ends.

Sunday

Sep 4th

This day fine weather with light variable winds. ship cruising round the islands looking hard for a whale but see none, saw one sail so ends.

Monday

Sep 5th

This day light breeze. ship cruising around the land sent a boat in after potatoes got in bushel. saw a school of black fish so ends.

Tuesday

Sep 6th 1881

This day strong breeze and squally weather, cruising round the land spoke the whaling schooner Edward Lee from Provincetown Capt. Sprake came on board, two months out sea. nothing been seen so ends.

Wednesday

Sep 7th

This day blowing strong from the S ship on point looks saw nothing except one sail and the land

Thursday

Sep 8th

This day fine weather ship on point looks good breeze cruising round the land saw killers grampas porpoises fish so ends

Friday

Sep 9th

This day fine weather with good breezes from the S.E. ship cruising round the land saw three sail cow fish porpoises but no whales.

Saturday

Sep 10th

First and middle part moderate breezes from the S.E. latter part blowing strong shortened sail. ship cruising round the islands about 7 AM spoke Bark Reinder, Capt. Baker bound to Flores. been to Fayal, saw one other sail. so ends.

Sunday

Sep 11th

This day strong breeze and foggy weather ship cruising saw the Reinder and one other sail also the land porpoises but no whales so ends this day.
