Sep 12th 1881,

This day strong breeze. ship kept off for Faya. Capt. & Wife went ashore about 9 A.M. Reindeer came in also the Bark A. H. Tucker schooner Lotie Cook

Tuesday

Sep 13th

This day good weather. ship laying off and on at Faya. landed our oil ashore, and took recruits 150 lbs potatoes 6000 Onions, two quarters of beef apples & peaches. schooner Pedro Vera arrived also one other schooner.

Wednesday

Sep 14th

This day squally weather laying off Faya. Capt. & Wife came on board about 3 O'clock. kept off steering South.

Thursday

Sep 15th

This day strong breeze from the N.W. ship steering S.E. & S. men employed stowing away potatoes & onions nothing been seen

Friday

Sep 16th

This day strong breeze from the N.W. ship steering S.E. nothing been seen and nothing new to write so ends

Saturday

Sep 17th

This day fine weather with moderate breeze from the N.W. ship steering S.E. men employed breaking out schocks saw a steamer so ends.

Sunday.

Sep 18th

This day light-breeze from the E.N.E. ship on the wind heading S.E. all sail out-saw a sun-fish, nothing more. so ends.

Monday

Sep 19th

This day light-breeze from the S.W. ship steering S.E. saw one sail steering to the S.W. toward a boat to engine his longitude but could not get up to her. cooper setting up schocks so ends.

Tuesday.

Sep 20th

This day fine weather with moderate breeze from the N.W. ship steering S.E. later part S. saw three sails so ends this day.

Wednesday.

Sep 21st

This day light-breeze from the S.E. ship steering S.W. & W. saw the land and several sails. men employed stowing away coals so ends this day

Thursday.

Sep 22nd

This day moderate breeze from the E by N ship on opposite tack working up to the land Tenerife saw a beach do not know what it was. so ends.

Friday

Sep 23rd

This day moderate breeze from the E.N.E. ship working up to the harbor of Tenerife. got up to it and took a pilot-dropped anchor about 4 O'clock the John & Minthrop. Reindeer and several schooners at anchor. so ends.

Saturday

Sep 24th

Fine weather light-breeze. could not get water to day. this afternoon the Pedro Varela and Bark F. H. Hill arrived. Capt. Baker came on board so ends this day.
