

Sunday Sep 25th 1881 Lat 16.00
Long 20.5
This day fine weather ship still at anchor took the water boat along side and filled to hundred the Capt & Wife went ashore. so ends

Monday Sep 26th
This day a dead calm no wind to get out. Bark Attleborough arrived nothing to write so ends

Tuesday Sep 27th Lat 14.20
Long 20.29
This day very light breeze took our anchor about 7 O'clock A.M. and stood out of the harbor Capt & Wife came on board early this morning. nothing been seen so ends this day.

Wednesday Sep 28th Lat 25.52
Long 16.56
This day good weather with light breeze from the ENE. ship steering S by N & W. nothing been seen so ends.

Thursday Sep 29 Lat 24.4
Long 18.45
This day good breezes from the ENE ship steering S by N & W. nothing been seen to day so ends.

Friday Sep 30th Lat 22.15
Long 20.37
This day good trades. ship steering S by S & S. all sail out. nothing been seen broke out slops and sold the crew clothing. Cooper employed sheathing the deck. so ends this day.

Saturday Oct 1st Lat 19.12
Long 20.45
This day strong trades. ship steering S & W. employed sheathing deck saw one sail and a fin back so ends this day.

Sunday Oct 2nd 1881
This day blowing strong ship steering S by W. about 3 PM, wind hauled into the N by E. blowing strong shortened sail nothing been seen so ends

Monday Oct 3rd
This day strong breezes and heavy rain squalls ship on the wind heading S by W. no observation and nothing been seen so ends.

Tuesday Oct 4th
This day very light-variable breezes some times heading S W. and some times W. saw a piece of squid and ship jacks cooper employed sheathing deck so ends another day.

Wednesday Oct 5th
This day light-buffling winds with frequent rain squalls. ship trying to get to the South nothing been seen to day and nothing to write about. no observation so ends.

Thursday Oct 6th Lat 18.9
Long 20.53
This day a calm ship scarcely moves nothing been seen, and nothing new to write so ends

Friday Oct 7th Lat 12.44
This day a calm, weather very hot thermometer at 92 deg in the shade saw a school of black fish lowered down the bow boat but did not get any cooper employed sheathing deck so ends.
