Long 13.27 Thursday Jan 12th 1882
This day light-breezes from the S.W. ship working to the N. employed boiling saw two fin backs so ends.

Lat-36.34
Long 13.3 Friday Jan 13th
First part of this day ship on the wind heading N.W. middle and latter part steering S.E. by S. finished boiling early this morning the whales turned up 99 lbs. nothing been seen except porpoises

Lat-37.24
Long 16.17 Saturday Jan 14th
This day strong breezes from the N.W. ship under short sails working to the S.E. employed stowing oil saw one sail so ends this day.

Lat-37.19
Long 17.34 Sunday Jan 15th
This day very light-breezes from the S. ship on the wind working to the S.E. spoke the Austrian merchant bark, Pacosia Captⁿ, eighty days from New York bound to para. compared longitudes and they agreed within six miles. so ends.

Lat-37.9
Long 18.27 Monday Jan 16th
This day first part dead calm middle and latter part light-breezes from the S.W. ship working to the S.E. saw one sail, employed scraping bone so ends this day.

Lat-37.21
Long 20.22 Tuesday Jan 17th
This day light-baffling winds ship working to the S.E. frequent rain squalls during the day. employed scraping bone saw one sail steering to the N.E.

Lat-37.17 Wednesday Jan 18th 1882
This day very light-breezes from the N.W. ship steering S.E. employed breaking out-provisions and stowing them properly also broke out-slop cash and supplied the crew broke out-flour ^{sugar} saw one sail.

Lat-37.53
Long 24.43 Thursday Jan 19th
This day good weather with moderate breezes from the N. ship steering S.E. nothing been seen except porpoises and right-whale feed, employed washing ship

Lat-37.54
Long 27.16 Friday Jan 20th
This day moderate breezes from the N. ship steering S.E. weather fine finished cleaning ship nothing been seen so ends.

Lat-38.44
Long 30.37 Saturday Jan 21st
This day good breezes from the N.E. ship steering S.E. by E. saw several fin backs and a school of porpoises so ends this day.

Lat-38.58
Long 34.10 Sunday Jan 22nd
This day moderate breezes from the N.W. ship steering S.E. by E. all sail out-saw one sail and fin back so ends.

Lat-38.20
Long 36.51 Monday Jan 23rd
This day very strong breezes from the S ship on the wind working to the S.E. saw porpoises, nothing to write so ends.

Lat-37.20
Long 38.46 Tuesday Jan 24th
This day strong breeze from the S.E. ship on the wind very heavy swell, employed in ships duty saw porpoises so ends.
