Tuesday Aug 29th 1882

This day moderate breeze from the S.E. ship on the wind working to the S. men employed in the rigging, nothing been seen

Wednesday Aug 30th

This day quite a strong breeze from the S.E. with heavy rain ship on the wind about ten o'clock raised Norfolk Island to the windward

Thursday Aug 31st

This day strong breeze from the N. with heavy rain saw Norfolk about 2 P.M. on weather bow, employed breaking out cloth casks, so ends.

Wednesday Sep 13th

This day light breeze from the S.E. Capt. Brightman & wife came on board about ten o'clock made sail and kept off steering N.

Thursday Sep 14th

Lat-29.29

Long 167.7 East

This day good breeze from the S.E. ship on the wind heading S.W. all sail out, saw hump back employed painting the boats so ends.

Lat-30.57

Friday Sep 15th

This day very strong breeze from the S. with a head beat sea ship on the wind working to the S.W. nothing been seen to day so ends.

Lat-31-7

Long 162.47

Saturday Sep 16th

This day strong breeze from the S.E. ship steering S.W. weather squally saw a large number of birds so ends.

Lat-32.6

Long 159.57

Sunday

Sep 17th 1882.

This day good weather with good breeze from the S.E. ship steering S.W. about 12 M. sighted Lord Howe Island a long way off. nothing else been seen except birds

Long 158.42

Monday

Sep 18th

This day first and middle part weather fine latter part thick and rainy wind from the N. ship steering S.W. by S. saw fish and porpoises employed cooping casks.

Lat-34.42

Long 156.56

Tuesday

Sep 19th

This day beautiful and fine light-breeze from the N.E. ship steering S.W. saw hump backs so ends.

Lat-35.32

Long 155.46

Wednesday Sep 20th

This day strong breeze from the S.W. ship on the wind working to the S and E, saw porpoises and fin backs, presented two Kings with the gold watch he having raised whales the most times that we have taken them so ends this day.

Lat-36.59

Long 156.12

Thursday

Sep 21st

This day strong breeze from the N.W. ship on the wind heading S.W. nothing been seen but fin backs and fish.

Lat-37.34

Long 153.27

Friday

Sep 22nd

This day strong breeze from the N.S.W. ship on the wind, a very nasty sea on saw several fin backs.

Lat-37.14

Long 154.31

Saturday

Sep 23rd

This day strong breeze from the S.W. ship on the wind heading N by N. caught a porpoise saw several fin backs so ends.
