This day strong breeze from the SW ship on the wind working to the S saw porpoises and albatross so ends.

This day light breeze and calm, ship working to the south, caught a porpoise saw a seal but no whales to be seen, so ends.

Oct-13th

Lat-38.31

Long 154.29

This day light breezes from the SW ship steering SSE, nothing been seen except fin backs.

Saturday

Oct-14th

Lat-39.5

Long 154.19

This day good breezes from the NW ship on the wind about 7.30 A.M. George Vincent raised a right whale lowered three boats and the Larboard boat struck got it along side about 12 M. got dinner and commenced to cut got it cut in about dark.

Long 154.32

This day a calm, employed boiling weather fine nothing been seen to day so ends.

This day moderate breezes from the NW ship on opposite tack saw a large number of fin backs, finished boiling about 11 A.M. whale turned up over 80 lbs.

This day strong breeze from the NW SW ship working to the NW. employed slowing down oil, saw fin backs.

Wednesday

Oct-18th

Lat-38.47

Long 155.1

This day moderate breezes from the NW to SW ship on opposite tack nothing except fin backs been seen so ends.

Thursday

Oct-19th

This day first and middle part a calm latter part moderate breeze from the N ship steering W by S, saw grampass so ends this day, no seen.

Friday

Oct-20th

Lat-39.30

Long 155.23

This day very light breezes from the N ship steering W by N. at dark shortened sail and stove ships, been thick and foggy nearly all day saw one fin back so ends.

Saturday

Oct-21st

Lat-39.22

Long 153.38

This day blowing a gale from the SE ship bore too under storm sails,

Oct-22nd

Lat-38.53

Long 154.3

This day good breezes from the SE first and middle parts on the wind latter part steering N. saw a number of fin backs so ends.
