steering SSE, saw fin backs killers and
porpoises. employed moving the fresh water
from the fore hold into the after hold.

This day good breeze from the SE ship
on both backs saw a number of fin backs

Long 153.16 This day good weather ship on the
wind heading SE by S saw several fin
backs. so ends this day.

breeze from the ENE ship on the

of fin backs nothing new to write

Wednesday Nov 1st

This day blowing a gale from the
W. ship under storm sail so ends.

Thursday Nov 2nd

Blowing a gale from the WSW. at sun
down moderating ship under short sail
signaled a large English merchant-
bark steering to the N. also saw fin backs.

Friday Nov 3rd

This day strong breeze and equally
wind from the SW. ship steering East
nothing but porpoises been seen.

Saturday Nov 4th

Fine weather with moderate breeze
from the SSE ship on the wind
heading E. saw a school of right-whale
porpoises and one fin back so ends.

Sunday Nov 5th

This day fine weather with moderate
breezes from the W. ship steering SE by S
saw a number of fin backs and porpoises
caught three right-whale porpoises to night.

Monday Nov 6th

First and middle part fine with light
breeze, latter part rising with strong breeze
saw fin back and group of so ends.

Tuesday Nov 7th

Blowing strong from the SW. ship steering
to the SSE. saw several fin backs and a
breach. should like to see and get a
whale.
