Thursday Nov 9th
This day strong breeze from the S.W. ship on the wind working to the S and E. nothing been seen to day. Put up the stove in the cabin. This day ends with thick fog.

Lat-46.19
Long 163.00 Friday Nov 10th
First and middle part a calm latter part light-breeze from the N.W. ship steering S. saw a school of porpoises and grampas. so ends this day.

Lat-48.26
Long 163.00 Saturday Nov 11th
This day strong breeze from the N. first part steering S.S.E. middle and latter part S.E. saw porpoises

Lat-49.5
Long 166.49 Sunday Nov 12th
This day strong breeze from the N.W. ship steering E.N.E. all sail out saw porpoises

Monday Nov 13th
This day good breeze from the N. ship steering N.E. & N. all sail out saw fin backs and porpoises so ends

Lat-46.50
Long 173.39 Tuesday Nov 14th
Good weather with strong breeze from the E.S.E. ship steering N.E. by N. nothing been seen and nothing to write so ends.

Lat-44.38
Long 176.25 Wednesday Nov 15th
This day good breeze from the E.S.E. ship on the wind heading N.E. saw sulphur bottoms and a large number of birds broke out eight-horns so ends,

Lat-44.8
Long 177.27 Thursday Nov 16th 1882
This day very light-breezes from the E.S.E. ship on the wind heading N.E. saw one fin back so ends this day.

Lat-44.18
Long 177.57 Friday Nov 17th
Fine weather with very light-breeze from the N.E. ship on the wind working to the E. saw any number of birds, nothing to write no whales. Dry times.

Lat-44.34
Long 179.33 Saturday Nov 18th
This day fine weather with light-breezes from the S.W. ship steering E by S. all sail out saw black fish so ends.

Lat-44.39
Long 178.41 Sunday Nov 19th
This day light-breezes from the N ship steering E by N.E. weather fine nothing been seen so ends this day.

Lat-44.24
Long 175.53 Monday Nov 20th
This day good breeze from the N.W. ship steering N.E. by E. at day light raised Charlton island, saw three sails a whales carcass and hump backs spoke bark Splendid Capt. ~~Coole~~ came on board.

Lat-44.8
Long 174.26 Tuesday Nov 21st
This day very light-breezes from the N.W. ship steering N. nothing to write seen nothing. weather very fine

Lat-48.25
Long 173.44 Wednesday Nov 22nd
This day fine weather, ship steering N.N.E. saw fin backs, spoke the blubber W. Morgan about dark Capt. S. New Brighton went on board of her and spent the evening
