Dec 7th

Long 170.7

This day fine weather with light-breezes from the E. ship on the wind heading N.W. at sunset wore ship and shortened sail saw any amount of fin backs saw the Chas. W. Morgan

Friday

Dec 8th

Long 170.18

Fine weather with very light-breeze from the S.E. ship on opposite tack saw any amount of fin backs also saw the Chas. W. Morgan cutting. we employed boiling find the blubber very poor bits very slow indeed,

Saturday

Dec 9th

Long 169.58

This day fine weather with light-breeze from the S.W. ship steering N.W. about 10 A.M. the Cook raised right-whale lured all the boats and the landward boat struck, took it along side and got to cutting about 2 O'clock got through about 6 P.M. the Chas. W. Morgan lowered her boats but got none so ends.

Sunday.

Dec 10th

Lat-38.44

This day quite strong breezes from the S.W. ship on opposite tack employed boiling nothing been seen except the Chas. W. Morgan, Wm Sayer under the influence of liquor.

Monday

Dec 11th 1882

Long 170.10

Fine weather with light-breezes from the S. ship on the wind under short-sail employed stowing oil finished boiling about 5 P.M. saw one fin back and the Chas. W. Morgan.

Tuesday

Dec 12th

Lat-38.36

Long 170.7

Fine weather with light-breezes from the S.W. ship on the wind working to the S saw fin backs, killer, and black fish.

Wednesday

Dec 13th

Lat-38.36

Long 169.43

Fine weather still continues with light-breeze from the S.W. ship steering N.W. saw fin backs and one sail.

Thursday

Dec 14th

This day moderate breezes from the S.E. ship on both tacks nothing been seen to day except fin backs so ends.

Friday

Dec 15th

This day very light-breezes from S.W. ship working to the S, nothing been seen to day.

Saturday

Dec 16th

Lat-39.00

Long 169.18

This day moderate breezes from the W. ship on opposite tacks looking hard for whale but see none nothing except one fin back

Sunday

Dec 17th

Lat-38.44

Long 169.11

This day fine weather with light-breezes from the W. ship on opposite tacks trying to get to the West nothing except fin backs been seen.
