

Lat-44.7 Monday Jan 29<sup>th</sup> 1883 Lat-42.11

Long 175.46 Strong breeze from the S. ship on both tacks Lat-42.11  
saw the land the forty four and round island  
also one sail to the inward so ends.

Lat-44.7 Tuesday Jan 30<sup>th</sup> Lat-39.43

Long 175.26 Moderate breeze from the S.W. ship on opposite  
tacks nothing been seen except two sails  
men repaired the sprinker so ends.

Lat-44.18 Wednesday Jan 31<sup>st</sup> Lat-37.57

Long 175.27 This day very light breeze from the N.W.  
ship on both tacks trying to get to the West  
saw two sails carpenter finished the waist  
boat and put it on the house. so ends.

Thursday Feb 1<sup>st</sup> Lat-36.11

This day strong breeze from the N.W. ship on  
both tacks the land and Pyramid in sight  
also the Chat. Morgan, & Adeline Gibb no whales.

Friday Feb 2<sup>nd</sup> Lat-35.34

This day light breeze from the S.W. stood into  
the land and sent a boat ashore, and it  
returned, came in a thick fog and a calm

Saturday Feb 3<sup>rd</sup> Lat-34.56

This morning a light breeze dropped our  
anchor and sent a boat ashore after recruits  
returned with potatoes, fifteen sheep, onions, and fish

Sunday Feb 4<sup>th</sup> Lat-34.10

Lat-43.38 This day fine weather with light breeze from the  
Long 175.47 N.W. ship on the wind working to the N.W. saw  
forty four this morning nothing else been seen

Lat-43.5 Monday Feb 5<sup>th</sup> Lat-31.02

This day blowing strong from the N.W. ship  
on the wind on opposite tacks killed ten  
sheep, saw any amount of gonies so ends.

Tuesday Feb 6<sup>th</sup> 1883

This day strong breeze from the S.W. ship  
steering N.W. by N. all sail out. nothing  
been seen except gonies so ends.

Wednesday Feb 7<sup>th</sup>

Fine weather with moderate breeze  
from the S.W. ship steering N.W. by N. employed  
mending flyjib and picked over the potatoes  
nothing been seen to day so ends.

Thursday Feb 8<sup>th</sup>

Fine weather with good breeze from  
the S.W. ship steering N.W. by N. took down  
the mainsail and repaired it and bent  
it again. nothing been seen so ends.

Friday Feb 9<sup>th</sup>

Fine weather with light breeze from  
the N.W. ship on the wind heading N.W.  
employed repairing the upper main top sail  
nothing been seen,

Saturday Feb 10<sup>th</sup>

This day very light breeze from the N.W.  
ship on the wind working to the N.W. employed  
breaking out strops and supplied the crew  
also broke out duck, ropes and chum.

Sunday Feb 11<sup>th</sup>

This day light breeze from the N.W.  
ship steering N.W. nothing been seen

Monday Feb 12<sup>th</sup>

Moderate breeze from the S.W. ship  
steering N.W. by N. weather squally some rain  
nothing been seen and no observation,

Tuesday Feb 13<sup>th</sup>

This day strong breeze from S.W. ship  
steering N.W. about 6 PM raised French rock  
at dark shortened sail and luffed to the wind
