 Long 176.10 Light breeze from the S.E. ship steering
 N. nothing been seen everything quiet

Monday July 16th
 Blowing strong from the E.S.E. ship on the
 port back heading S. weather thick and
 rainy no observation so ends on other day.

Lat-26.18 Tuesday July 17th
 Long 176.38 Blowing strong from the S. ship on point
 lacks weather squally nothing been seen.

Lat-26.18 Wednesday July 18th 1893
 Long 176.15 Light breeze from the S. ship steering E.N.E.
 saw one sail employed making spun yarn

Thursday July 19th
 Fine weather with light breeze from
 the W. ship steering E by N. nothing seen

Friday July 20th
 Lat-26.36 Long 175.22 Light breeze from the N.W. ship steering
 E.N.E. nothing been seen to day employ-
 ed taring down so ends.

Saturday July 21st
 Lat-26.21 Long 174.9 Strong breeze from the N.W. ship on
 the wind working to the N.E. weather
 thick and rainy, nothing been seen

Sunday July 22nd
 Lat-25.53 Long 173.8 Light breeze from the S.W. ship steering
 E by N. saw the Fort-Harrison steering to
 the N. by West so ends on other day.

Monday July 23rd
 Lat-25.35 Long 171.52 Good breeze from the S. ship on the
 wind heading E.S.E. nothing been seen

Tuesday July 24th
 Lat-25.57 Long 172.8 Good breeze from the S.E. ship steering
 S.W. nothing been seen except one Coney.

Wednesday July 25th
 Strong breeze from the N.E. ship steering W
 saw one sail called it a whale so ends
 with no observation weather thick.

Thursday July 26th
 Blowing strong from the N.W. with heavy
 rain, more moderate to night nothing
 been seen and nothing to write so ends.
