Lat-24.45 Saturday July 28th
Long 174.33 Light breezes from the S.W. ship on
the wind heading W.N.W. all sail out
saw fin backs and fish so ends.

Sunday July 29th
This day calm and light breeze from
the W.N.W. ship on the wind saw nothing

Lat-24.42 Monday July 30th
Long 175.11 Strong breezes from the W. weather
squally ship on the wind saw fin
backs and a breach so ends.

Lat-24.18 Tuesday July 31st
Long 176.31 Strong breezes from the W.S.W. ship on
opposite tack nothing been seen.

Lat-24.31 Wednesday Aug 1st
Moderate breezes from the W.S.W. ship
on the wind working to the W.N.W.

Thursday Aug 2nd
Strong breezes and squally weather wind
from the S.W. ship on the wind working
to the W by N nothing been seen so ends.

Lat-24.15 Friday Aug 3rd
Long 177.37 Moderate breezes from the S.S.E. ship on the
wind heading S.W. employed making spinn
jarn. nothing been seen so ends.

Lat-23.50 Saturday Aug 4th
Long 178.20 First and middle part a calm latter
part moderate breezes from the S.E. ship on
the wind working to the S saw porpoises
employed repairing fore gallant sail and
fore stay sail so ends this day.

Lat-24.11 Sunday Aug 5th 1883
Long 178.44 This day calm and light baffling
winds. ship trying to get to the South
winds to night from the S with rain squalls
nothing been seen to day except fish.

Lat-24.38 Monday Aug 6th
Long 178.3 Strong breeze from the S. ship on the
wind heading W.S.W. nothing been seen
employed repairing misser top sail.

Lat-25.3 Tuesday Aug 7th
Long 179.42 Strong breezes from the S.E. ship steering
W.S.W. at sunset shortened sail and came
to the wind on port tack nothing living
been seen employed mending upper main
top sail nothing to write of any account

Lat-25.20 Wednesday Aug 8th
Long 178.35 Strong breezes from the E. ship steering
East W by S nothing been seen to day employed
mending lower main top sail so ends.

Lat-24.36 Thursday Aug 9th
Long 177.53 Strong breezes from the E. ship steering S.W.
nothing living in sight employed mending
fore stay sail so ends

Lat-24.54 Friday Aug 10th
Long 176.59 Good breezes from the E.N.E. ship steering
W by N all sail out nothing been seen
very dry times want a whale very bad.

Lat-24.56 Saturday Aug 11th
Long 176.22 Very strong breezes from the E.N.E. ship on
the wind working to the N. nothing seen.

Sunday Aug 12th
Blowing strong from the East ship under
short sail saw one bird and that looked
frightened dry times very dry.
