Lat-23. 45 Wednesday Aug 15th

Long 176. 30 First and middle part a dead calm latter part very light breeze from the S.W. ship steering E.N.E. employed painting the boats nothing been seen so ends.

Lat-23. 27 Thursday Aug 16th

Long 177. 24 Light breeze from the S.W. ship steering E by N. employed painting the boats nothing been seen so ends on other day.

Lat-23. 27 Friday Aug 17th

Long 178. 46 Moderate breeze from the S. ship steering E.N.E. under full sail nothing been seen.

Lat-23. 3 Saturday Aug 18th

Long 179. 43 This day moderate breeze from the S by S ship on the wind working to the N.E. saw black fish, finbacks. Antone one of the foremast hands off duty sick been sick some few days broke out bread and flour.

Long 179. 23 Strong breeze from the E.S.E. ship on the wind working to the N.E. at dark shortened sail nothing been seen.

Monday Aug 20th 1883

Strong breeze from the E.S.E. ship steering first part N.N.E. middle and latter part W.S.W. saw the land to night the island of Ono. Mr Sayer sick. Antone about the same no whales been seen looking hard for one.

Tuesday Aug 21st

Blowing strong from the E by S. ship on the wind under short sail saw the land but it was too rugged to run down to it; nothing else been seen Mr Sayer better

Wednesday Aug 22nd

Strong breezes from the E. ship laying off and on Ono. waiting for canoe to come off. none came sent a boat in but did not land took one man and brought him on board and then carried him back broke out a keg of butter and sugar also molasses.

Thursday Aug 23rd

Strong breezes from the N.E. ship laying off and on at Ono. two boats went ashore brought off the boat loads of yams and coconuts also bananas fowls &c.

Friday Aug 24th

Moderate breezes from the N.W. ship laying off and on at Ono. sent two boats ashore returned about 2. O'clock with some stuff coconuts fowls and yams and bananas kept along on the wind heading W.S.W.

Saturday Aug 25th

Strong breezes from the S by E. ship on the wind working to the S.W. employed stripping broom stuff and putting away the yams.
