Long 178.47 Strong breezes from the SE by E. ship on
East the wind heading S by W. nothing been seen

Lat 22.41 Monday Aug 27th
Long 177.58 Very strong breezes from the E by S. ship on
the wind heading S by E. employed painting
Starboard boat, nothing been seen so ends.

Lat 24.25 Tuesday Aug 28th
Long 177.49 Strong breezes from the ENE ship on the
wind heading SE, nothing been seen to
day nothing new to write so ends.

Lat 25.55 Wednesday Aug 29th
Long 178.6 Good breezes from the NE by E ship on both
tacks, under full sail trying to get to the E
nothing been seen broke out flour so ends.

Thursday Aug 30th
Strong breezes from the NE, with rain ship
on the wind heading ESE, at dark shortened
sail nothing been seen so ends

Friday Aug 31st
First and middle part blowing strong
from the NE, middle part shifted
changed into the WNW, made sail
steering ENE, the first part was rainy

Lat 26.2 Saturday Sep 1st
Long 179.56 Light breezes from the SW ship steering
W E by N. saw one sail steering some way.

Sunday Sep 2nd
Moderate breezes from the E by S. ship on the
wind heading NE rainy weather no observations

Lat 25.18 Monday Sep 3rd
Long 178.36 Moderate breezes from the SW ship steering
E, nothing been seen so ends.

Lat 25.29 Tuesday Sep 4th 1883
Long 177.4 Good breezes from the SW ship steering
E & N, saw hump backs so ends

Lat 25.30 Wednesday Sep 5th
Long 175.3 Light breezes from the SSW ship steering
E, nothing been seen employed mending
the mainsail so ends.

Lat 25.36 Thursday Sep 6th
Long 174.42 Good breezes from the N ship steering
E, saw hump backs, employed repairing
the mainsail so ends this day.

Friday Sep 7th
Lat 26.1 Good breezes from the NW ship steering
Long 170.11 E, at sunset shortened sail and luffed
on the wind heading NNE, saw jumpers
finished the mainsail and bent it sent
down the spanker and repaired that bent
it again so ends this day.

Lat 26.24 Saturday Sep 8th
Long 169.15 Strong breeze from the SW ship on opposite
tacks, rose new main braces and lower
main topsail braces nothing been seen
broke out water and flour.

Lat 26.25 Sunday Sep 9th
Long 168.31 Light breezes from the SSW ship on the
wind heading SE, saw breeches at sun
set shortened sail so ends this day.

Monday Sep 10th
This day a calm employed mending
foulsail nothing been seen nothing to
write so ends.
