Strong breeze from the N.W. ship stood on opposite tack nothing been seen except finbacks weather thick employed boiling broke out bag of sugar 35 lbs.

Thursday Nov 22nd
Strong breeze from the N.W. first part ship on the wind heading N.W. middle and latter part steering N by W. finished boiling about 11 A.M. whale turned up 68 lbs saw nothing except the Adeline Gibbs so ends.

Friday Nov 23rd
Light breeze from the S.E. first part steering N.W. middle and latter part on the wind working to the S.W. employed slowing down oil in the aft hold saw any amount of black fish, and right whale porpoises, also one sail. broke out cheese, beans, syrup, kerosene, desiccated potatoes, dried apples &c.

Saturday Nov 24th
Moderate breeze from the E.N.E. to E.S.E. ship on the wind working to the S.E. all sail out, employed slowing down the remainder of the oil slowed down in all 554⁶⁶ 178 gal 30 months out 2400 lbs all told looking hard for more. saw nothing except birds and fish

Sunday Nov 25th
Good breeze from the E by N. ship on both tacks on one tack heading S.E. on the other N by E. saw the Alaska steering to the N. also saw several fin backs.

Long 170.17
Monday Nov 26th 1883
Strong breeze from the E. ship on the wind heading N.N.E. nothing been seen except a few finbacks so ends this day.

Tuesday Nov 27th
Moderate breeze from the E by S. ship stood on opposite tack nothing been seen except a few finbacks

Lat-36.19
Long 170.20
Wednesday Nov 28th
Moderate breeze from the E.S.E. first and middle part working to the S.W. latter part heading N.E. nothing been seen except a few finbacks so ends this day

Lat-36.33
Long 170.11
Thursday Nov 29th
Good breeze from the S.E. first and middle part working to the S. latter part wore ship heading N.E. by E. nothing been seen.

Friday Nov 30th
Moderate breeze from the E by N. first part on the wind middle and latter part steering S by E. shortened sail at sun set and bluffed on the wind heading S.E. nothing been seen except birds

Lat-38.27
Long 170.5
Saturday Dec 1st
Very light breeze from the E.N.E. ship steering S by E saw three fin backs and a school of porpoises dry lines again weather clear and fine

Lat-38.54
Long 170.7
Sunday Dec 2nd
Very light breeze from the N by E ship on the wind working to the E. saw a large number of fin backs in the night black fish and porpoises were around the ship
