Long 161.7 Good breeze from the N.N.W. first and middle part steering S by E. latter part on the wind heading S.W. employed mending sails upper and lower fore top sails nothing been seen weather clear and cool so ends this day.

Lat-47.57 Friday Jan 11th
Long 162.7 Strong breeze from the N.W. ship on the wind heading N.W. saw two fin backs and some kills. broke out beef pork & bread also syrup. mended the fore stay sail so ends this day.

Lat-47.57 Saturday Jan 12th
Long 163.59 Strong breeze from the N.W. ship on the wind working to the West nothing been seen to day weather quite thick.

Lat-47.3 Sunday Jan 13th
Long 165.19 strong breeze from the N.W. ship on the wind heading N.W. saw several fin backs and a school of right whale porpoises

Lat-46.46 Monday Jan 14th
Long 166.23 This day blowing strong from the N. ship on the wind working to the Westward saw several fin backs so ends.

Lat-46.17 Tuesday Jan 15th
Long 167.49 First and middle part strong breeze from the N.W. by S. ship steering N.W. by N. latter part wind from the N. ship on the wind heading S.S.W. saw a school of cow fish

Lat-46.20 Wednesday Jan 16th/1854
Long 169.10 Blowing a gale from the N. first and middle part ship on the starboard tack latter part on the port tack blowing very hard and weather thick nothing been seen. barometer very low

Lat-46.46 Thursday Jan 17th
Long none This day strong breeze from the N. ship steering N.W. by N. weather thick and rainy nothing been seen about 2 O'clock our little dog Tip died so ends.

Lat-46.36 Friday Jan 18th
Long 170.31 First and middle part blowing a gale from the N. ship on the port tack about 1 O'clock wore ship heading N.N.W. weather moderating. made sail very heavy swell on. nothing been seen to day.

Lat-46.22 Saturday Jan 19th
Long 171.38 Blowing still from the N.W. with heavy rain in squalls. ship on the wind under storm sail nothing been seen employed washing ship so ends.

Lat-46.21 Sunday Jan 20th
Long 171.20 Still blowing strong from the N. ship on the port tack heading N.W. weather moderating somewhat to sight.

Lat-45.55 Monday Jan 21st
Long 171.1 First and middle part a calm latter part strong breeze from the N.E. ship steering N.W. by N. all sail out nothing been seen employed overhauling the blocks
