Saturday

July 5th 1884

Long 176.10 Strong breezes from the S & E ship on the wind working to the E. saw one fin back and fish men employed generally so ends.

Lat-23.59

Sunday

July 6th

Long 175.23 Weather squally wind from the S & E ship on the wind working to the S & W. nothing been seen to day.

Lat-23.51

Monday

July 7th

Long 175.53 First part very light breezes from the S & E. middle and latter part good breeze from the same about 7 A.M. John boatster raised a lone sperm whale going about N & W. lowered the boats for him but they gallied him in the morning and chased all day but without success it was a very large whale and we feel bad to lose it.

Lat-23.18

Tuesday

July 8th

Long 176.22 This day light breezes from the S & E ship stood on opposite tacks during the day men employed generally nothing been seen so ends.

Lat-23.36

Wednesday

July 9th

Long 175.55 Light breezes from the S & E ship on the wind working to the S & W. men employed generally saw several fin backs broke out a bag of sugar 56 lbs also flour so ends.

Lat-23.50

Thursday

July 10th 1884

Long 176.27 Very light baffling winds from S & E to the S ship on the wind working to the S & W. employed mending lower main top sail nothing been seen except a fin back and fish so ends this day.

Friday

July 11th

Lat-23.45 This day calms and light baffling winds from S to S & W. ship trying to get to the S & E. men employed mending the main gallant sail saw fin backs and hump backs. had several showers through the day. nothing new to write.

Lat-23.50

Saturday

July 12th

Long 176.23 This day calms and light airs from all directions with frequent showers of rain. ship trying to get to the S & E nothing been seen to day.

Lat-24.21

Sunday

July 13th

Long 175.33 Strong breeze from the S & W. ship on the wind working to the S & E at sun set shortened sail nothing been seen except fin back and fish.

Lat-24.40

Monday

July 14th

Long 174.24 Good breezes from the S & E ship on the wind working to the E. saw several fin backs. men employed doing various jobs.

Lat-24.34

Tuesday

July 15th

Long 173.13 Light breezes from the S & E ship on the wind heading S & E. men employed repairing upper main top sail weather fine but nothing been seen.
