

Lat-22.37 Sunday July 27th 1884
Long 174.2 Light breezes from the N.W. ship
steering S by W. fine weather nothing
been seen so ends this day.

Lat-23.25 Monday July 28th
Long 173.53 This day calm and light breezes
from the N. ship on the wind working
to the S and W. employed rattling down
the main rigging, and repairing the
spanker. weather good so ends.

Lat-23.37 Tuesday July 29th
Long 173.55 Very light breezes from the S. ship
on the wind working to the S.W.
weather cloudy with little rain
finished rattling down the main
rigging saw several fin backs.

Wednesday July 30th
First and middle part of this day
wind very light and baffling latter
part good breeze from the E.S.E. ship
steering S.W. by W. rainy. employed
rattling down the mizzen rigging
no observation nothing been seen.

Lat-24.56 Thursday July 31st
Long 176.37 Strong breeze from the S.E. with
rain. first and middle part steering
W by S & S. latter part shortened sail
and luffed on the wind heading S.S.W.
blowing quite strong with rain washed
ship during the day nothing been seen.

Lat-25.10 Friday Aug 1st 1884
Long 178.56 Strong breezes from the S.E. ship
steering W by S. weather good employed
rattling down the mizzen rigging
nothing been seen so ends.

Saturday Aug 2nd
This day good breezes from the E.S.E.
ship steering W by S under full sail
employed coopers the bread and flour
broke out beef & pork & flour. saw fin back
no observation rainy in squalls.

Lat-25.9 Sunday Aug 3rd
Long 176.48 Good breezes from the S ship steering
W by S all sail out nothing been seen
to day and nothing to write about so ends.

Lat-25.9 Monday Aug 4th
Long 174.39 This day good breezes from the S by E
ship on the wind heading W by S men
employed taking down scraping masts
and coal taring the windlass and other
odd jobs nothing been seen so ends.

Lat-24.41 Tuesday Aug 5th
Long 173.18 Very light-baffling winds from all
quarters ship to night on the wind heading
S.W. by S. employed repairing the fly
jib, scraping down the masts and
rattling the main gallant-rigging
caught a porpoise last night.

Lat-24.58 Wednesday Aug 6th
Long 172.35 Strong breezes and squally weather
wind to night S. ship steering N.S.W.
nothing been seen employed
generally so ends.
