

Lat-31.42 Tuesday Sep 9th 1884
Long 170.11 First and middle part of this day
strong breeze with rain from the
N.W. ship steering E by S. Latter part
wind from the S.E. ship on the wind
heading E.N.E. finished the main sail
and bent it - nothing been seen.

Lat-31.19 Wednesday Sep 10th
Long 171.41 Very light breeze from the E.S.E. ship
on the wind nothing been seen
employed painting the boats.

Lat-31.22 Thursday Sep 11th
Long 172.4 Very light breeze from the N.W. ship
steering E. broke out beef & molasses
and shifted water from the after
hold nothing been seen so ends.

Lat-31.53 Friday Sep 12th
Long 174.14 Strong breeze from the N.W. ship
steering E. with all sail out saw
several fin backs. rose new lower main
top sail braces and put the old ones
forward also changed the main brace
end for end.

Lat-32.17 Saturday Sep 13th
Strong breeze from the N. weather
squally with rain ship steering
E. nothing been seen. no longitude

Lat-32.48 Sunday Sep 14th
Long 178.58 Strong breeze from the S.W. ship
steering E. weather squally nothing
been seen except birds

Lat-33.00 Monday Sep 15th
Long 175.42 Strong breeze from the S.W. ship steering
E. employed mending fore gallant sail
nothing been seen so ends

Lat-33.24 Tuesday Sep 16th 1884
Long 172.52 Strong breeze from the N. ship
steering E by S. saw several fin backs
employed repairing the fore and
main gallant sails finished them
and bent them broke out - flour.

Lat-34.12 Wednesday Sep 17th
Long 170.23 Moderate breeze from the N.E. ship
steering E by S. at sun set
shortened sail and luffed on the
wind heading S. nothing been seen
repaired fore top mast stay sail. broke
out a bag of sugar 56 lbs so ends.

Lat-34.54 Thursday Sep 18th
Long 169.38 Good breeze from the N. ship steering
S.E. by E. at dark shortened sail and
luffed too. weather thick look like
rain picked over the potatoes in
the house nothing been seen.

Friday Sep 19th
This day moderate breeze from the
N.W. ship steering E.S.E. shiny and
quite thick most of the day. shortened
sail at dark and luffed too heading
S.W. saw any amount of fin backs at
night. no observation so ends.

Lat-35.40 Saturday Sep 20th
Long 167.57 Strong breeze from the W by S. ship
stood on fore & back saw several
fin backs. nothing new to write.
